NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Pursuant to M.G.L. c. 141, §2 and c. 30A, §2, the Board of State Examiners of Electricians will hold a public hearing relative to proposed promulgation of amendments to the Board's regulations at 237 CMR 13.00. By these amendments, the Board is proposing to increase the amount of time education and work experience which may be utilized for licensure purposes. A small business impact statement is on file with the Secretary of State's Office regarding these changes. The hearing will be held at 10:00 a.m. on Monday, December 16, 2019 at 1000 Washington Street, 1st Floor, in Boston. Interested Parties will be given an opportunity to present testimony orally or in writing at this hearing.
