NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Pursuant to M.G.L. c. 142, §4, 13 and c. 30A, §2, the Board of State Examiners of Plumbers and Gas Fitters will hold a public hearing relative to proposed promulgation of amendments to the Board's regulations at 248 CMR 3.00, 4.00, 5.00, 10.00, and 11.00. By these amendments, the Board seeks to clarify permitting requirements, the scope of gas fitting, requirements for gas piping, materials used in plumbing, and the time required to obtain plumbing licensure. A small business impact statement is on file with the Secretary of State's Office regarding these changes. The hearing will be held at 9:00 a.m. on Wednesday, January 8, 2020 at Quincy High School, 100 Coddington Street in Quincy. Interested Parties will be given an opportunity to present testimony orally or in writing at this hearing.
