## DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURAL RESOURCES <u>NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING</u>

Notice is hereby given that the Department of Agricultural Resources, under its authority pursuant to Chapter 333 of the Acts 2016, as amended by Chapter 108 of the Acts of 2021, "An Act further regulating hen welfare and establishing cage-free standards," and in accordance with M.G.L. c. 30A, will hold a public hearing on proposed draft regulations at 330 CMR 35.00. 330 CMR 35.00 codifies the Department's role in the implementation of this legislation, which is intended to prevent animal cruelty by phasing out certain methods of farm animal confinement in the hopes of reducing potential fiscal and health threats to Massachusetts consumers. In general, the Regulation impacts anyone involved in the production and/or sale of veal meat, pork meat, shell eggs, and egg products in the Commonwealth.
