NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

Notice is hereby given that the Massachusetts Department of Conservation and Recreation (DCR) (successor to the former Metropolitan District Commission), acting under its authority pursuant to M.G.L. c. 92A ½, §§2, 19; St. 1972, c. 737; St. 1990, c. 436, and in conformity with M.G.L. chapter 30A, will hold a public hearing on the proposed rescission of 350 CMR 8.00 (*Land Within Watershed Reservations*). (Contemporaneous with the rescission of 350 CMR 8.00 will be amendments to 313 CMR 11.00 (*Watershed Protection*) which will move the substantive provisions of 350 CMR 8.00 into 313 CMR 11.00.)

A public hearing will be held via videoconference and telephone conference call and will be open to the public. You may join via computer or telephone as described below.
