**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

Notice is hereby given that the Executive Office for Administration and Finance, working with the Department of Conservation and Recreation (DCR), acting under statutory authority of Chapter 7 of the General Laws, and in conformance with chapter 30A, §2 of the General Laws, will hold public hearings on proposed amendments to portions of 801 CMR 4.02 [*Fees for Licenses, Permits, and Services to be Charged by State Agencies*] regarding fees charged for camping and parking; annual parking passes for non-residents of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts; parking for veterans, disabled veterans, Purple Heart recipients, Gold Star Families, and active service members; and parking and boat rental fees related to the Quabbin Reservoir Fishing Program.
