## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Pursuant to M.G.L. c. 30A, § 2 and M.G.L. c. 6D, the Health Policy Commission (the "Commission") will hold a public hearing regarding **proposed amendments to 958 CMR 3.000** – **Health Insurance Consumer Protection.** 

The proposed amendments are authorized by M.G.L. c. 6D, § 16 and c. 176O § 13 through 16 and align the existing regulation with changes enacted pursuant to Chapter 177 of the Acts of 2022, *An Act Addressing Barriers to Care for Mental Health*.
