

**NOTICE REGARDING JUVENILE COURT STANDING ORDER 2-23:  
Access to Records and the Role of the Judge in Family Treatment Court**

Juvenile Court Standing Order 2-23: *Access to Records and the Role of the Judge in Family Treatment Court* is effective on December 8, 2023. The standing order is applicable to any Family Treatment Court (FTC) held within a division of the Juvenile Court Department including but not limited to FTCs established under the Juvenile Court's **PATHS** program and replaces Juvenile Court Standing Order 1-23: *Access to Records and the Role of the Judge in the Family Treatment Court*. The standing order addresses access to FTC records and the role of the Juvenile Court judge as it relates to the FTC and the concurrently held care and protection matter.
