



## Precipitation & Departures



#### Precipitation

Accumulated Precipitation (inches) October 1, 2025 - October 31, 2025






- 3-6" inch totals for western/central MA/Nantucket
- 4-8" for southeast MA
- 8-10" for South Shore/outer Cape

#### Departure from Normal

Precipitation Departure from Normal (inches) October 1, 2025 - October 31, 2025



- Generally within I" of normal for western/central MA and Nantucket
- Up to 4-6" above normal for southeast MA


## 3 and 6 Month Percent of Normal



#### Last 3 Months (August-October)

- Generally within 20 % of climatological normal
- Pockets of 60-80% of normal for central/western MA
- Nantucket 40-80% of norma


Precipitation Percent of Normal August 1, 2025 - October 31, 2025



#### Last 6 Months (May - October)

- Near Normal since May I<sup>st</sup>
- South Shore well above normal (120-140%)
- Nantucket only 40-80 % of normal


Precipitation Percent of Normal May 1, 2025 - October 31, 2025



## Long Range Ensemble Forecast


7 Day High End/Low End Forecast Precipitation Amounts

- 100 Forecast Models
- ~90 predict 7 Day QPF > 0.2-0.4"

- ~10 predict 7 Day QPF > 1.2-1.4"




## 7 Day Precipitation Forecast



## Boston/Norton MA WEATHER FORECAST OFFICE


- Three Potential Rainfall Events
   Cold front (Wed night/Thu.)
   Fri night/Saturday morning
   Early next week
- 0.25 0.75" of rain forecast through next Wednesday
- Highest amounts central/west
   MA and Nantucket (>0.5")




## Outlook: November 10<sup>th</sup> -14th



Odds favor near normal precipitation with below normal temperatures very likely







## Outlook: November 12th - 18th



#### Leaning slightly below normal precipitation with near normal temperatures likely







## Outlook: November 15<sup>th</sup>-November 28<sup>th</sup>

#### Leaning Above Normal Temperatures







## Outlook for Nov, Dec, Jan

#### Equal Chances for Above/Below Normal Precipitation.

### Above Normal Temperatures Likely







#### October:

- 3-10" accumulations across The Commonwealth
- Departures -I to +6 inches
- Southeast MA 3-6" above normal
- Central/Western MA and Nantucket 0-1" below normal

#### Longer Range Precipitation Departures:

- 3-month near normal for most of state, below normal central/west MA and Nantucket, above normal South Shore
- 6-month Near Normal since May Ist
- South Shore 6-month well above normal (120-140%)
- Nantucket 6-month only 40-80 % of normal

#### Outlook:

- ▼ 7 Day Outlook is favorable for appreciable rainfall (0.25 0.75")
- Outlook leaning near or below normal beyond 7 days
