Welcome to the Farmers' Market!

A farmers' market is a place where farmers sell their products directly to consumers. You'll find them set up once or twice a week in your community selling fresh, just-picked seasonal Massachusetts-grown fruits and vegetables. Farmers' markets offer an amazing array of produce that you don't always see in your supermarket.

Farmers go to great lengths to provide the most nutritious items possible by picking produce right before it is sent to the market, and to offer several varieties of fruits and vegetables. Each farmer may have different varieties of apples, corn, tomatoes, or peppers. At the market, you can learn how to cook and store unfamiliar produce. Try something new!

Farmers' markets serve not just as a place for buying fresh produce, but also as a place for people to connect as a community, build relationships and learn where food comes from. Support your health and your local farmers by buying nutritious fresh foods!

Using Your Farmers' Market Coupons

What Are Farmers' Market Coupons?

These are coupons that can be used to purchase fresh picked vegetables and fruits grown and sold by local farmers at farmers' markets. The coupons cannot be used at the grocery store.

What Can You Buy With the Coupons?

You can use your coupons to buy fresh, locally grown fruits and vegetables, fresh cut herbs, and honey. Other items available for sale at the market cannot be purchased with senior farmers' market coupons. Fruit and vegetable choices may differ from market to market and at different times during the season. To get an idea of what may be available, see the availability chart on page 7. Not every market will have the same items – it depends on what your local farmer is growing!

How Do I Use Them?

Coupons can only be accepted by participating farmers at farmers' markets or farm stands. Check the opening and closing dates for the markets at www.mass.gov/massgrown.

Each coupon is worth \$2.50 and no change can be given. It is recommended that you bring small bills and change. In the event that you go over the amount, you will need to pay the difference.

Look for the Signs

Many farmers' markets also accept SNAP benefits (Food Stamps). Some may even double the value! Go to www.mass.gov/massgrown to find out if your market accepts SNAP or check with the farmers' market manager.





Meet a Community Leader!

Jennifer Putnam Nutrition Program Director at the Greater Springfield Senior Services

How long have you been serving as **Nutrition Program Director, and** what do you enjoy most about your position?

I've been working here for two and a half years now and what I like most about my position is that we are able to serve our consumers healthy, nutritious foods to help them stay in their homes longer.

What does an average day in the office look like to you?

The morning is very busy. We are a big program with 26 traditional routes, 1 kosher route and 2 therapeutic meal routes, serving approximately 1,100 traditional home delivered meals per day. I begin by making sure all paperwork gets to the route drivers so they know where to go.

How does Greater Springfield Senior Services help seniors access fresh fruits and vegetables?

Mainly through home deliveries and congregate meals. Starting in June and for the rest of the summer, when we have funding, we like to send pints of fresh berries along with their meals!



Do you have a mobile market in your service area, or other innovative ideas to help seniors access fresh fruits and vegetables?

We do have one mobile market in Springfield. We provide our clients with a list of farmers' markets so that they can find a market nearby. This way they can still take advantage of the farmers' market and get quality produce right near where they live!

Are you able to frequent farmers' markets in the area during the summer?

I buy local all summer; I get my own fruits and vegetables at the farmers' market.



Healthy Incentives Program



What is HIP?

HIP can help you buy more locally grown fruits and vegetables. When you buy fruits and vegetables with SNAP at participating farmers markets, mobile markets, farm stands or Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) farm share programs, you will earn extra money on your SNAP/ EBT card.

How does HIP work?

HIP matches SNAP/Food Stamp dollars spent on eligible fruits and vegetables at participating farmers markets, mobile markets, farm stands and CSA farm share programs up to a maximum monthly benefit based on the size of your household. You will need to SPEND SNAP dollars on fruits and vegetables to EARN HIP incentives. It's easy to earn HIP and the incentive is added directly back to your SNAP/EBT card and can be used towards any future SNAP eligible purchase.

What are HIP eligible fruits and vegetables?

HIP eligible foods are fresh, canned, dried and frozen fruits and vegetables without added sugar, salt, fats or oils.

What is the maximum HIP benefit I can earn each month?

HIP incentives depend upon the number of members in your household. You can earn an additional \$40.00 for a 1-2 member household, \$60.00 for a 3-5 member household, and \$80.00 for a 6+ member household.

Where can I earn HIP benefits?

You can earn HIP benefits by shopping at participating farmers markets, mobile markets, farm stands and CSA farm share programs throughout the state, and buying HIP eligible fruits and vegetables. HIP benefits cannot be earned at other food stores such as supermarkets, convenience stores, or bodegas, however you can spend your earned HIP benefit at these locations on any future SNAP purchase. To find a participating HIP retailer near you go to www.mass.gov/HIP. Look for the HIP logo when shopping at participating farmers markets!

Smart Buying at the • Farmers' Market

- Take your time and walk around the market and look at everything before you decide what to buy.
- Compare prices, varieties and quality.
- If you see a new fruit or vegetable, don't be shy! Farmers love to talk about their produce, so ask questions. They might have suggestions for new recipes!
- Have recipes or meal ideas ready for the fruits and vegetables you buy.
- Buy local fruits and vegetables in season from your local farmers' market. They are not only fresh but taste delicious!

Healthy Cooking Tips

- Try grilling, roasting or stir-frying vegetables.
- Choose olive or canola oil instead of butter, margarine or lard.
- Reduce salt in recipes and use garlic and fresh herbs like basil and cilantro for added flavor.

Fruits & Veggies: How Many Do I Need?

Most adults need about 4 to 5 cups of fruits and vegetables every day.

Here are some examples of a cup:

- 1 cup leafy raw vegetables
- 1 cup chopped vegetables or fruit (fresh, frozen and canned all count!)
- l large ear of corn
- 8 large strawberries
- 1 medium piece of fruit like an apple or peach





Keep your fruits and vegetables fresh for as long as possible!

- Store tomatoes and fruit with pits, like peaches and plums, on the counter until ripe.
- Most other fruits should be kept in the refrigerator.
- Store most vegetables in the refrigerator in the crisper to keep them cool and moist.
- Potatoes, onions and winter squash can be stored in a cool, dry place.
- Make sure to store any cut fruit or vegetables covered in the refrigerator.

Simple Summer Squash Bake

Ingredients:

- 3 servings 4. Fill an 8x8 baking dish with the squash and sprinkle bread crumb mixture on top.
 - Cover the dish with foil and bake for 30 minutes. Remove foil and bake until the top is crispy.



- 2 tbsp. olive oil
- 1/4 cup parmesan cheese
- 2 1/2 tbsp. bread crumbs
- l lb summer squash
- Pinch of salt and ground pepper

Instructions:

- Preheat the oven to 350°F. 1.
- 2. Slice the squash into medallion shapes and toss with olive oil.
- 3. In a small bowl, combine bread crumbs, cheese, salt and pepper.

'Spicy' Fruit Salad

Ingredients:

- 2 fresh fruits diced to make 2 cups of pears and apples
- $1/4 \operatorname{cup} 100\%$ orange juice
- 1/8 tsp cinnamon or nutmeg

Instructions:

- 1. Wash and dice fruit and place in medium bowl.
- 2. Pour 100% juice over fruit.
- Sprinkle cinnamon or nutmeg on top of the fruit.
- 4. Mix together all ingredients.
- 5. Serve. Refrigerate any leftovers.
