



Welcome to the Farmers' Market!

A farmers' market is a place where farmers sell their products directly to consumers. You'll find them set up once or twice a week in your community selling fresh, just-picked seasonal Massachusetts-grown fruits and vegetables. Farmers' markets offer an amazing array of produce that you don't always find in your supermarket.

Farmers go to great lengths to provide the most nutritious items possible by picking produce right before it is sent to the market to be sold, and to offer several varieties of fruits and vegetables. Each farmer may have different varieties of apples, corn, tomatoes, or peppers. At the market, you can learn how to cook and store unfamiliar produce. Try something new!

Farmers' markets serve not just as a place for buying fresh produce, but also as a place for people to connect as a community, build relationships and learn where food comes from. Support your health and your local farmers by buying nutritious fresh foods!





Using Your Farmers' Market Coupons

What Are Farmers' Market Coupons?

These are coupons that can be used to purchase fresh picked vegetables and fruits grown and sold by local farmers at farmers' markets. The coupons cannot be used at the grocery store.

What Can You Buy With the Coupons?

You can use your coupons to buy fresh, locally grown fruits and vegetables, fresh cut herbs, and honey. Other items available for sale at the market cannot be purchased with senior farmers' market coupons. Fruit and vegetable choices may differ from market to market and at different times during the season. To get an idea of what may be available, see the availability chart on page 7. Not every market will have the same items – it depends on what your local farmer is growing!

How Do I Use Them?

Coupons can only be accepted by participating farmers at farmers' markets or farm stands. Check the opening and closing dates for the markets at www.mass.gov/massgrown.

Each coupon is worth \$2.50 and no change can be given. It is recommended that you bring small bills and change. In the event that you go over the amount, you are responsible for paying the difference.

Look for the Signs

Many farmers' markets also accept SNAP benefits (Food Stamps). Some may even double the value! Go to www.mass.gov/massgrown to find out if your market accepts SNAP or check with the farmers' market manager.

Let's get active!

Why should I exercise?

Regular exercise may improve muscle strength and cardiovascular fitness, and decrease the risk of falling. It can also improve your mood and quality of sleep, and lower risk for some chronic diseases.

How often should I exercise?

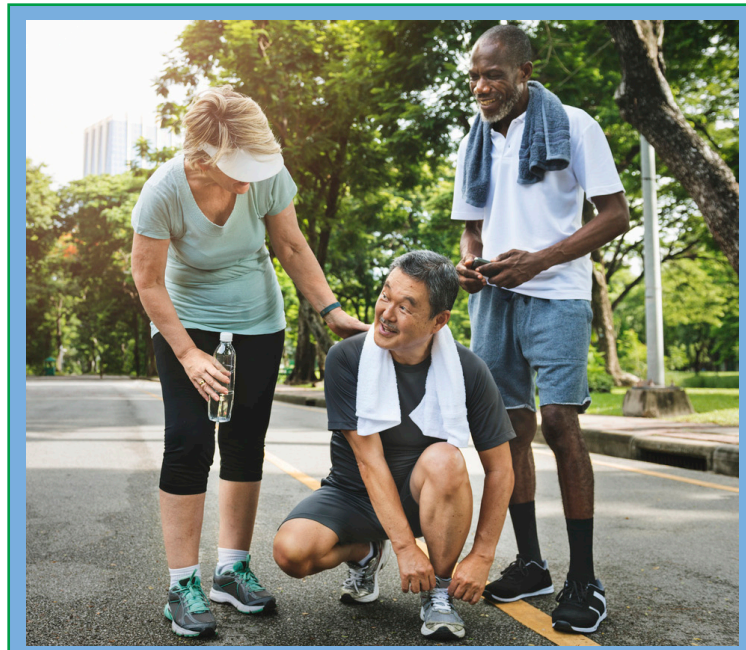
Aim for at least 2 hours and 30 minutes of moderate aerobic exercise, or 1 hour and 15 minutes of vigorous aerobic exercise per week. Aerobic exercises include walking, hiking, biking, dancing, and swimming. Even 10 minute bouts of exercise have been found to have an impact on health.

What other types of exercise should I do?

Strength, balance, and flexibility exercises can all be beneficial. Strength exercises include using bands or weight machines, gardening, carrying groceries, and climbing stairs. Balance and flexibility exercises include yoga and tai chi.

How can I make exercise more fun?

Find something you enjoy doing. Try a competitive activity, or a group class. Check with your local senior or community center for low-cost exercise classes for older adults!



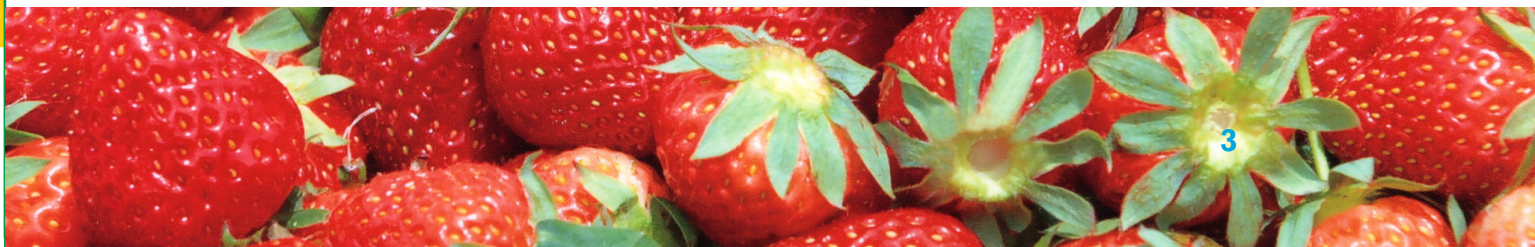
What if I don't usually exercise or want to try something new?

Start slowly and gradually build your way up to your desired goal. Be sure to speak with your physician before starting a new exercise program!

What if I have a chronic health condition?

Speak to your physician about what types of exercise would be beneficial for you. Many chronic health issues can be improved with exercise.

Smart Buying at the Farmers' Market

- Take your time and walk around the market and look at everything before you decide what to buy.
- Compare prices, varieties and quality.
- If you see a new fruit or vegetable, don't be shy! Farmers love to talk about their produce, so ask questions. They might have suggestions for new recipes!
- Have recipes or meal ideas ready for the fruits and vegetables you buy.
- Buy local fruits and vegetables in season from your local farmers' market. They are not only fresh but taste delicious!

Healthy Cooking Tips

- Try grilling, roasting or stir-frying vegetables.
- Choose olive or canola oil instead of butter, margarine or lard.
- Reduce salt in recipes and use garlic and fresh herbs like basil and cilantro for added flavor.

Fruits & Veggies: How Many Do I Need?

Most adults need about 4 to 5 cups of fruits and vegetables every day.

Here are some examples of a cup:

- 1 cup leafy raw vegetables
- 1 cup chopped vegetables or fruit (fresh, frozen and canned all count!)
- 1 large ear of corn
- 8 large strawberries
- 1 medium piece of fruit like an apple or peach



Storing Fruits and Vegetables: How do I do it?

Keep your fruits and vegetables fresh for as long as possible!

- Store tomatoes and fruit with pits, like peaches and plums, on the counter until ripe.
- Most other fruits should be kept in the refrigerator.
- Store most vegetables in the refrigerator in the crisper to keep them cool and moist.
- Potatoes, onions and winter squash can be stored in a cool, dry place.
- Make sure to store any cut fruit or vegetables covered in the refrigerator.



Farmers' Market Recipes

Peachy Pops

Ingredients:

- 1 peach
- 1/4 cup vanilla non-fat yogurt
- 1 cup orange juice
- 4 paper cups (5 oz)
- 4 spoons
- Aluminum foil



Instructions:

4 servings

1. Wash and chop peach. Divide among the 4 paper cups.
2. In a medium bowl, mix yogurt and orange juice together until blended.
3. Pour juice mixture over peaches and place a spoon in each cup.
4. Cut aluminum foil to cover tops of cups, piercing each with spoon handle (foil will hold spoon in cup).
5. Freeze for at least 4 hours.
6. Peel the paper cups from the pops and enjoy!

Crunchy Vegetable Burritos

Ingredients:

- 1/2 cup carrots, shredded
- 1/2 cup broccoli, chopped
- 1/2 cup cauliflower, chopped
- 2 green onions, thinly sliced
- 1/2 cup low-fat cheddar cheese, shredded
- 1/4 cup low-fat ranch dressing
- 1/2 teaspoon chili powder
- 1 cup lettuce, torn into bite size pieces
- 4 flour tortillas

Healthy Tips:

Try using whole-wheat or corn tortillas, adding beans, or substituting salsa for ranch dressing.

Instructions:

4 servings

1. Wash and prepare vegetables.
2. Combine vegetables with cheese, dressing and chili powder. Mix well.
3. Spoon about 1/2 cup vegetable mixture and 1/4 cup lettuce into the center of each tortilla.
4. Wrap each tortilla around the vegetable mixture. Serve cold.
