DECISION

Coop Deville, Inc. 12 Circuit Ave Oak Bluffs, MA 02557 License #: 091800058 Heard: September 27, 2011

Coop Deville, Inc. (the "Licensee") holds an all alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, §12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, September 27, 2011, regarding an alleged violation of M.G.L. c.138, §34. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Jamie Binienda's Compliance Check Field Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

1. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts; and

2. Compliance Check Field Report dated July 16, 2011.

There is one (1) tape of this hearing.

FACTS

1. On, July 25, 2011 at approximately 6:12 p.m., Commission Investigators investigated the business operation Coop Deville, Inc.

2. An underage operative, working with the investigators, possessed a Bud Light. The underage operative was not asked for identification.

3. Administrative review of the licensee's files indicates the license has a violation in 2001 and has been in business for twenty-three (23) years.

CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated M.G.L. c. 138, §34. Therefore, the Commission suspends the license for three (3) days of which three (3) days will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations occur.
