Right Lane Closure on I-90 (Mass Pike)

Westbound

Between Beacon Street and the Prudential Center

Starting Wednesday, October 1st, 2025

BOSTON - The Massachusetts Department of Transportation (MassDOT) is announcing a right lane closure on I-90 (Massachusetts Turnpike) in the westbound direction between the Prudential Center and Beacon Street to support ongoing construction activity related to the Bowker Overpass Replacement Project.

Work to prepare the traffic signage and construction area will occur Sunday September 28th through Tuesday September 30th between the hours of 8:30 pm to 5:00 am. The vehicular barriers will be installed, and pavement markings will be modified during the overnight shift on Tuesday night September 30th. The fixed closure will begin Wednesday morning, October 1st, 2025.

Drivers on I-90 Westbound should expect a reduction from four lanes to three lanes with the right lane (slow lane) converted to a fixed work zone in the vicinity of the Bowker Overpass. The lane closure will be marked with appropriate signage and traffic control devices. Drivers should expect reduced speed zones and potential delays when traveling through the work zone.

The work is being conducted as part of an \$84 million project to replace the Bowker Overpass bridge over I-90 in Boston.
