

Massachusetts Department of Revenue Quarterly Tax Collection Benchmark Estimates

Benchmark estimates represent an allocation by quarter of the most recent official annual estimate. This allocation is based on historical patterns of tax collections with adjustments for tax law changes. The benchmarks reflect the quarterly levels of tax collections that are needed to reach the annual estimate. Deviations of actual collections from quarterly benchmarks are expected. If the annual estimate is accurate, year-to-date deviations should diminish as the fiscal year proceeds.
