### Purpose of Public Involvement Plan (PIP)

- The purpose of the PIP is to ensure meaningful access to services, programs, activities, and materials for all persons, regardless of race, color, national origin, ethnicity or ancestry, disability, class, income, gender identity, sexual orientation, religious belief, or English language proficiency.
- The PIP provides a framework for effective public involvement that engages the impacted community and solicits meaningful public input.

# Execution of Effective Public Outreach – EEA Public Involvement Plan (PIP)



- Develop a public involvement plan strategy for decision-making processes regarding the development, implementation, and enforcement of environmental laws, regulations, and policies, including climate change policies, that promote inclusivity.
- EEA commits to inclusivity by following procedures that consist of:
  - Engaging early on with constituents
  - Keeping constituents informed at every stage of the decision-making process, from the initial proposal to the final implementation, to foster trust and transparency.
  - Being intentional when seeking public input
- Incorporate public input in decision-making to the extent possible by law.



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### Elements of Staff Training – EEA Public Involvement Plan (PIP)



 Conduct EEA-wide staff training to ensure staff understands and implements the concept of environmental justice principles in accordance with the

Climate Roadmap Act.

- Identify EJ communities
- Translate materials
- Minimize industry jargon
- Provide interpretation services
- Provide equitable access to public meetings



### Administration of EEA Public Involvement Plan (PIP)



- This PIP is a living document that will be formally updated every two years to reflect changes in community needs, ensuring that the community remains our top priority.
- The Offices of the Secretary shall use this PIP as a guide to develop outreach plans tailored to their key agency actions, activities, or programs:
  - Coastal Zone Management
  - OTA
  - MEPA
  - MEP
- Each agency under the EEA's purview is developing its respective Public Involvement Plan, using the EEA's PIP as a module, and tailoring it to its key agency actions, activities, or programs.



### **DPU Public Involvement Plan (PIP)**

- Assesses if a Department proceeding or action will have a disproportionate impact on EJ populations
- Requires greater levels of publication and community outreach for significant proceedings
- Identifies best practices to enhance public participation and community engagement

## **Key Practices - DPU Public Involvement Plan (PIP)**




- Conduct outreach to stakeholders, including community-based organizations, to publicize opportunities to provide feedback for significant Department initiated proceedings
- Require petitioners to conduct outreach to municipal and community leaders at least 30 days prior to filing a petition with the Department for significant proceedings initiated by the petitioner
- Translate vital documents and provide interpretation for significant proceedings so that all people can participate and provide input regardless of English language proficiency.
- Increase messaging via Department social media channels and website, including information useful for Environmental Justice (EJ) populations



## **Key Practices - DPU Public Involvement Plan (PIP)**



- Consider time, location, availability of public transportation when scheduling public hearings
- Include information in notices on nature of the proceeding, how to file comments or attend public hearings, comment deadlines, how to request language access services, and key contact information
- Review and consider all comments submitted in a proceeding and address them as appropriate in the order issued
- Share PIP with staff, management, and leadership, and provide staff training on processes and practices
