



Precipitation & Departures

Accumulated Precipitation (inches) September 1, 2025 - September 30, 2025







- 3-4" inch totals for western/central MA
- 4-6" for southeast MA
- 1.5-3" ofor Cape/Islands

Departure from Normal

Precipitation Departure from Normal (inches) September 1, 2025 - September 30, 2025





Generally 0.5 to 1.5 inches below normal Up to 1-2" above normal for southeast MA Islands 1.5 to 3" below normal


3 and 6 Month Percent of Normal




Last 3 Months (July-September)

- Below normal since July 1st
- Generally 60-80% of climatological normal
- Pockets of 40-60% of normal
- Nantucket < 40% of normal

Precipitation Percent of Normal July 1, 2025 - September 30, 2025






Last 6 Months (April - September)

- Near Normal since March 1st
- Nantucket 40-60% of normal

Precipitation Percent of Normal April 1, 2025 - September 30, 2025



7 Day Precipitation Forecast

Tuesday 10/7-Tuesday 10/14

- Two Potential Rainfall Events
 Cold front Tuesday
 night/Wednesday
 Coastal storm this weekend
- 1.5 2.5" of rain forecast through early next week over southeast MA, Cape, and Islands
- 0.75-1.5" of rain across interior
 MA

Long Range Ensemble Forecast


10 Day High End/Low End Forecast Precipitation Amounts



- ~10 predict 10 Day QPF > 2-3"




Outlook: October 12th -16th




Outlook: October 14th -20th



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Odds favor near normal precipitation with above normal temperatures likely






Outlook: October 18th-October 31st




Equal Chances for Above or Below Normal Precip

Leaning Above Normal Temperatures




Outlook for Sep, Oct, Nov

Above Normal Temperatures Likely




Latest River Forecasts

EATHER SERVICE

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No river flooding anticipated during the next ten days.

- A 52 member ensemble run for all NERFC forecast points to give us an idea of the possible range of river flows out 10 days.
- No Flooding Forecast





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September:

- 3-6" accumulations across The Commonwealth
- Departures generally 0.5-1.5 inches below normal
- Southeast MA received 0.5 − 1.5 inches above norma.
- Cape/Islands 1.5 to 3" below normal

Longer Range Precipitation Departures:

- 3-month deficits for most of state (40-80% of normal)
- 6-month precipitation within 20% of normal across most of MA
- Nantucket (40-60% of normal last 6 months)

Outlook:

- 7 Day Outlook is favorable for appreciable rainfall
- Outlook leaning near or above normal beyond 7 days
