Education and Outreach

Since 30 September 2016, a total of 103 students have completed the online education component, a total 61 students have successfully completed both components of the education requirement. Education completion is down slightly, however, the amount of courses offered has increased.

Massachusetts Environmental Police Officers have conducted 13 Off-Highway Vehicle Safety and Responsibility Courses (Devens-1, Foxboro-1, Hanson-1, Lake Lorraine-1, Oxord-3, Plymouth-4, and Swansea-2), there are an additional 5 scheduled through the first week of June 2017 (Foxboro-2, Oxford-1, Plymouth-1, Swansea-1).

MEP has provided ASI/ATV training courses to Haverhill Police Department and subsequently qualified 6 officers. MEP is currently in the process of evaluating these training needs for first responder partner agencies and will be scheduling training accordingly.

MEP has recently received a new supply of OHV Safety Handbooks and expects to have those available for distribution soon.
