

Implementation Council Members*

WHO

- Up to 21 procured members elected each term (currently 13 members)
- 50%+ of Council made up of members with disabilities, family members or guardians
- Includes representatives of communitybased organizations
- Includes representatives of consumer advocacy organizations
- May include union representatives
- Includes providers representing the diverse communities affected by One Care

ROLES

- Advises EOHHS on the One Care program
- Participates in development of public education and outreach campaigns
- Monitors and examines access to health care (medical, behavioral health, and LTSS)
- Provides feedback on compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act
- Tracks and examines quality of services
- Promotes the program's accountability and transparency
- Develops annual work plan and meeting agendas
- Votes on motions and proposed actions

Potential Focus Areas for Work Plan Goals



- 1. Communication access and accessible outreach to individual members
- 2. Optimize access to One Care services for individual members, Care Teams, and One Care Plans
- 3. Leverage specialized One Care member-facing staff and community resources (e.g. the Long-Term Supports Coordinator and Certified Peer Support Specialists), including those with behavioral health expertise
- 4. Help assure succession planning for Implementation Council leadership

Topic areas for input

- 1. Distinguish the One Care program from other MassHealth programs
- 2. Protect individual consumer choice and care preferences by improving member education, quality of care, service utilization and overall experience within One Care program
- 3. Increase general understanding of vendor/plan relationship to improve quality of access to durable and non-durable medical supplies for One Care members
- 4. Ensure One Care plan care teams function at levels needed to meet member goals and ensure that plans take full advantage of two funding streams
