On March 1, 2010, Verizon New England Inc. d/b/a Verizon Massachusetts ("Verizon") filed a petition requesting that the Department eliminate the mandatory audit requirement in the Massachusetts Performance Assurance Plan ("PAP"). Verizon also requested that the Department require that any future audit of the PAP be based on a showing of good cause or "credible concern" of a CLEC or CLECs.

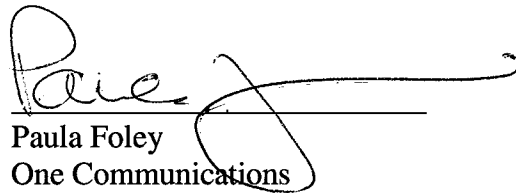
3. One Communications depends on Verizon to provide wholesale services to One Communications in order to serve its customers. A change in the mandatory PAP audit
