Subject: **OnTheMap Tool Information Session**

Purpose: To notify local Workforce Boards, One-Stop Career Center Operators and other local workforce development partners that Massachusetts data is now available for use with the U.S. Census Longitudinal Employer Household Dynamics (LEHD) OnTheMap tool. A demonstration of this tool will be conducted by a representative from the U.S. Census. This session is designed to introduce local LMI experts to this particular labor market information tool and provide an opportunity to learn more about how it can be applied.

Background: The US Census produces several labor market information tools combining federal, state and Census Bureau data on employers and employees under the [Local Employment Dynamics \(LED\) Partnership](#).

OnTheMap is an online mapping and reporting application showing where workers are employed and where they live with companion reports on worker characteristics and optional filtering by age, earnings, or industry groups. It provides an easy-to-use interface for creating, viewing, printing and downloading workforce related maps, profiles, and underlying data.
