1	PROCEEDINGS
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3	JOHN ROMANO: Good morning, everyone.
4	I guess we'll get started. My name is John Romano. I
5	am the Director of Outdoor Advertising for the Mass.
6	Department of Transportation. We are here for the
7	January 10, 2019 monthly public hearing.
8	If you haven't signed in, on the table
9	to my left is a sign-in sheet. There's also a copy of
10	the meeting notes and meeting agenda for last month
11	the notes for last month, the agenda for this month.
12	If you didn't sign in on your way in, you can on the
13	way out if you would like your name to be part of the
14	transcript record.
15	Also, this meeting is accessible to
16	people with disabilities and individuals with limited
17	English proficiency. If you have filed a request with
18	us for assistive technology, sign language, alternate
19	format documents, an interpreter, translated
20	documents, or other such services to be available here
21	today, please see Lydia here if you have not yet
22	received the assistance you need. I do not believe
23	any requests were made to us ahead of time.
24	LYDIA QUIRK: No.

1 JOHN ROMANO: If you need any other 2 similar assistance to participate today, please let 3 Lydia know, and we will do our best to help you. But, if we know about it in advance, we will be able to better accommodate you and make sure we have what you 5 6 Seeing none, we will proceed. need. 7 One thing that I do want to point out, just as a general reminder, one of the requirements in 8 9 all of our applications, whether it be electronic, 10 static, or unlicensed permits, is the notice to property owners. And there are a list of requirements 11 12 of what need to be in that notice. Please make sure you follow that and have all of the appropriate 13 14 information on there. It does not spell out what 15 needs to be in the notice in the regulations, but in 16 each application, I think it's page four or something, the top, it lists the specific items that need to be 17 18 in there. So, I just want to call that to everybody's 19 attention. 20 The other thing is that renewals are 21 ongoing, but we're probably at about 99 percent.

There's just a handful of people that we're still working on. Some, which are packages, may have got lost in the mail. But considering the hundreds and

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1	hundreds that we send out, I think we did pretty good.
2	We've only had a couple not get to their destination,
3	and virtually all of them we've touched based with in
4	the last day or two. So, I just want to thank
5	everybody for getting those in in a timely manner and
6	we're starting off the new year on a good foot. So,
7	thank you very much.
8	So, next, minutes from the December
9	public hearing. As I said, they are on the table on
10	the left. Any questions, comments, changes,
11	omissions, or anything like that?
12	(No response.)
13	JOHN ROMANO: Seeing none, we will mark
14	those approved. Today is the 10 th . Okay.
15	Okay. Next, the first item on the
16	agenda is an application for a permit transfer. This
17	is ION The Ball, LLC is the transferor to Outfront
18	Media, LLC is the transferee. This is Permit Number
19	2017D014. It is 126 Merrimack Street in Methuen.
20	Are either party here today? State
21	your name.
22	KEVIN ROWELL: Ken Rowell, Outfront
23	Media.
24	JOHN ROMANO: Thank you, Ken.

1	Ken, we've reviewed the documents that
2	you guys submitted, you know, the amendment excuse
3	me the transfer. I apologize. It seems all the
4	paperwork here is in order. The fee has been
5	submitted.
6	And, did you do that one, Marc?
7	MARC PLANTE: I think it was Jason.
8	JOHN ROMANO: Oh, sorry. Jason, could
9	you just give a quick
10	JASON BEAN: Yeah.
11	JOHN ROMANO: You did an inspection,
12	and just a quick review on it.
13	JASON BEAN: Yeah, no problem.
14	As you said, this is just a transfer
15	from one licensee to another located in Methuen, this
16	particular one. It's a digital as well as a back
17	side. At this time, through the review, we didn't
18	find anything to jump out as making this nonconforming
19	to the permitted sign. The only thing I can request
20	from the licensee is just to turn it on. They're both
21	dark. So, as early as possible, once you get your
22	paperwork, turn that thing on. We don't like them to
23	go dark for too long. And so, at this time, no
24	issues.

1	JOHN ROMANO: Great. Thanks.
2	Ken, anything you'd like to add?
3	KEN ROWELL: No.
4	JOHN ROMANO: Okay. Great. Thank you.
5	We will take this under advisement and we will get
6	back to you soon.
7	Okay. Next, is also a permit transfer.
8	It is Permit Number 2017D023, transferor I have a
9	hard time with these words, sorry transferor is
10	Cove Outdoor to the transferee is Outfront Media, LLC.
11	This is 79 Vine Street in Everett.
12	And is someone here from either party?
13	KEN ROWELL: Ken Rowell, Outfront
1 /	
14	Media.
15	Media. JOHN ROMANO: Thank you, Ken.
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15 16 17 18 19 20 21	JOHN ROMANO: Thank you, Ken. So, again, we reviewed all the paperwork on this one. The transfer paperwork is in order. The correct fee has been submitted. And I do have a couple of comments on this, but I am going to ask my inspector to first say I know this sign has not been built.

1	JOHN ROMANO: I'm sorry. Chris Chaves.
2	I apologize. He's the inspector.
3	CHRISTOPHER CHAVES: But there seems to
4	be no issue once it is built. This is a 2017/16
5	permitted sign, newly permitted. No issues in that
6	area.
7	JOHN ROMANO: Great. So, Ken, between
8	Cove Outdoor and an abutter, I know that there was an
9	agreement. We received that. There are some nuances
10	in that agreement about how the board will be turned
11	or whatever. We expect that you will follow all of
12	those that are in that agreement between Cove and the
13	abutter next door, and that as this transfers, it all
14	transfers to you guys.
15	KEN ROWELL: Yes, 100 percent.
16	JOHN ROMANO: Anything you'd like to
17	add?
18	KEN ROWELL: No.
19	JOHN ROMANO: Okay. Great. We will
20	take this under advisement and we will get back to
21	you.
22	Any questions, comments, concerns?
23	(No response.)
24	JOHN ROMANO: Okay. Thank you.

1	Okay. So, next we have an application
2	for a permit amendment. This is also Outfront Media,
3	LLC. This is an existing permit, 2011060, 1 City Hall
4	Square, Government Center. This is actually for a
5	piece of street furniture, a bicycle kiosk that is
6	actually going to just be relocated to a different
7	section of Government Center Plaza, or City Hall Plaza
8	I guess you could say. So, it's the same setup. It's
9	just being moved to another location.
10	Chris, did you do this one? So, Chris,
11	any information?
12	CHRISTOPHER CHAVES: No, no issues.
13	Street furniture, like you said, just moving from one
14	part of City Hall Plaza to the other. No issues.
15	JOHN ROMANO: Okay. And, Outfront
16	Media. Ken, state your name again for the record.
17	KEN ROWELL: Ken Rowell, Outfront
18	Media.
19	JOHN ROMANO: Great. Thank you.
20	Ken, we reviewed, you know, the
21	amendment. The paperwork is all in place, the
22	appropriate fee. As Chris said, he inspected it.
23	There are no issues from an inspection standpoint.
24	So, do you have anything you'd like to add at this

1	time?
2	KEN ROWELL: Not at this time.
3	JOHN ROMANO: Okay. Great. Any
4	comments, questions, concerns?
5	(No response.)
6	JOHN ROMANO: Okay. Seeing none, we
7	will take this under advisement and we will get back
8	to you.
9	Okay. Next is application for permits.
10	So, again, Outfront Media, LLC. These are a series of
11	existing bicycle kiosks, again, street furniture.
12	They are throughout the City of Boston. I believe
13	it's approximately 45 locations.
14	KEN ROWELL: Forty-two.
15	JOHN ROMANO: Forty-two. So, I am
16	going to do these all as one set. They are
17	applications 2018218 through 2018257. Unless somebody
18	has a question or a concern about any particular
19	location, which I will ask for that at the end, and we
20	will address it individually, I will, as I have with
21	groups of street furniture like this, I am going to do
22	them all as one unit.
23	So, both Chris Chaves, my inspector,
24	and Jason Bean, went out and inspected all of these

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1	locations. And so we will go right down here. So,
2	again, as I said, 2018218 through 257.
3	Notification was sent to the mayor and
4	the city clerk on December 11, 2018.
5	Is the applicant present?
6	KEN ROWELL: Ken Rowell, Outfront
7	Media.
8	JOHN ROMANO: Is anyone here
9	representing the municipality, the City of Boston?
10	(No response.)
11	JOHN ROMANO: Are there any abutters to
12	any of these locations present?
13	(No response.)
14	JOHN ROMANO: Is anybody present from
15	the MassHighway District Office?
16	(No response.)
17	JOHN ROMANO: Traffic Operations is N/A
18	because this is street furniture, so they do not have
19	to review these. And the same for abutter
20	notification is not required due to them being street
21	furniture.
22	And, Ken, special permit or variance,
23	they were signed each application individually was
24	signed off by the City of Boston and not subject to

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1	municipal zoning per their requirements. So, is that
2	your understanding on each of these?
3	KEN ROWELL: Yes.
4	JOHN ROMANO: So, I'm going to ask
5	Jason to give a kind of general overview and we'll
6	pull up one location. And all the rest have a pretty
7	similar setup, is basically the same.
8	So, Jason, if you could give your
9	JASON BEAN: Yes, thank you, John.
10	This particular example is on Columbia
11	Road at Mercer Street facing east. So, the picture
12	you're seeing, this is for 2018237. It's just a good
13	example that's indicative of what they look like and
14	the ad that's on them and generally the locations that
15	these are put in. With the street furniture, these
16	are allowed some regulatory exemptions. So, at this
17	time, we didn't find I should say I. I don't want
18	to speak for you. But didn't find any issues with the
19	permits, the lot of Outfront permits that we received.
20	JOHN ROMANO: Chris, anything you want
21	to add to that?
22	CHRISTOPHER CHAVES: No. No, not at
23	all. Jason said it well. Thank you, Jason.
24	JOHN ROMANO: And just to be clear with

1	everybody, each one of these locations were
2	individually inspected.
3	CHRISTOPHER CHAVES: Mm hum.
4	JOHN ROMANO: It wasn't we're not
5	blanketing the inspection. We're just the
6	discussion, we're pooling them together. But these
7	were individual applications and individual
8	inspections.
9	JASON BEAN: Some are at T stations and
10	then some are in these neighborhood type areas.
11	JOHN ROMANO: And, again, all of them
12	bikes. Great. Thank you. So, no issues again?
13	JASON BEAN: No issues.
14	JOHN ROMANO: Thank you very much.
15	Ken, anything you'd like to add to
16	these applications?
17	KEN ROWELL: Not at this time.
18	JOHN ROMANO: May I ask you to do one
19	favor? Can you spell your last name for the
20	stenographer?
21	KEN ROWELL: Yes, R-o-w-e-l-l.
22	JOHN ROMANO: Thank you. Appreciate
23	that.
24	Okay. Anybody have any questions,

1	comments, concerns on these?
2	(No response.)
3	JOHN ROMANO: Okay. Seeing none, we
4	will take this group under advisement and we will get
5	back to you.
6	JOHN ROMANO: Okay. Next is on the
7	agenda application for 2019 renewal of Outdoor
8	Advertising licenses and permits. As you can see,
9	there is 58 various license holders along with their
10	permits. And I do does anybody have any questions,
11	comments, concerns that you'd like to make?
12	(No response.)
13	JOHN ROMANO: I do want to add for the
14	record, and Lydia will send you a copy of this, we do
15	have a letter from Clear Channel regarding the 125
16	MBTA static billboard permits which they are, you
17	know, are making a letter in opposition to those. And
18	we will review the letter and we will also include it
19	as part of the record for this hearing.
20	So, Mike, anything you want to add or -
21	_
22	MIKE MAURELLO: No.
23	JOHN ROMANO: Okay. I'll just make a
24	note of that.

1	Mike Maurello from Clear Channel. Mike
2	Maurello.
3	Okay. Next, Item E is application for
4	renewal of unlicensed Outdoor Advertising permits.
5	There are 11 people that are renewing just unlicensed
6	permits.
7	Any questions, comments, concerns on
8	these?
9	(No response.)
10	JOHN ROMANO: Okay. Seeing none, the
11	next item is for the record, actions taken since our
12	last public hearing in December. There are a handful
13	of items listed here under this section. Does anybody
14	have any questions, comments, concerns on these?
15	(No response.)
16	JOHN ROMANO: Okay. Great. None.
17	And then, lastly, general public
18	comment. Anybody have any comments, questions,
19	concerns, issues?
20	(No response.)
21	JOHN ROMANO: Okay. Before we adjourn,
22	Jason just reminded me the list of public meeting
23	dates for 2019, which, of course, are the second
24	Thursday of every month at 11:00 in this room, but

1	they are posted on our site. So, in case you need to
2	look at those, they are all up there.
3	So, seeing no public comment, we are
4	adjourned. Thank you all very much. And, go
5	Patriots. Not everybody might be there, but we'll
6	see.
