PROCEEDINGS 1 2 3 JOHN ROMANO: Good morning, everybody. 4 My name is John Romano. I am the Director of Outdoor 5 Advertising for Mass. Department of Transportation. We are here for the January 9, 2020 public hearing for 6 7 Outdoor Advertising. This meeting is accessible to people 8 9 with disabilities and individuals with limited English 10 proficiency. If you had filed a request with us for 11 assistive technology, sign language, alternate format 12 documents, an interpreter, translated documents, or 13 other such services to be available here today, please see Lydia if you have not yet received the assistance 14 15 you need. We also can have amplification devices 16 available from Lydia for anybody who needs them. Ιf 17 you need any other similar assistance to participate 18 today, please let Lydia know and we will do our best to help you. But, obviously, if we are made aware 19 20 ahead of time, we will be sure to have those for you. 21 Thank you. 22 And I don't believe anybody has 23 requested anything in advance, correct? 24 LYDIA QUIRK: No.

JOHN ROMANO: Getting right to the 1 agenda, the first item, sign-in. On the table to my 2 3 left, there's a sign-in sheet. If you haven't signed 4 in yet, you can do so on your way out if you would 5 like to be part of the record. Also, there's a copy of today's agenda. 6 7 There are meeting notes from the December 12 meeting as well there. There's also a copy of the schedule 8 9 for the entire year for 2020. They're all the second Thursday of the month in this room. So, the schedule 10 is printed and they're also posted on our website if 11 12 you'd like to take a copy of those with you. 13 I do apologize in advance for the arctic conditions in the room. Unfortunately, my 14 15 office is not in control of the heat. And I can't speak for other departments but they're, obviously, 16 17 not as efficient as we are in Outdoor Advertising or it would be 68 degrees and comfortable. I'm sorry 18 about that. Unfortunately, it's like 58 degrees, but 19 it could be worse. If it was 58 outside, we'd be 20 21 happy I guess, right? So, December 12<sup>th</sup> public hearing meeting 22 minutes, any questions, comments, concerns, changes? 23 24 (No response.)

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1 JOHN ROMANO: Seeing none, we will mark 2 those approved. 3 Okay. The next item on the agenda, we 4 have an application from American Outdoor Advertising 5 Company. This is for a two-sided digital application, 150 Royall Street in Canton, MA. 6 It's a new structure. These are Application Numbers 2020D001 and 7 D002. 8 9 Notification was provided to the town 10 administrator and the town clerk on December 6, 2019 by my office. 11 12 Is the applicant present? 13 DAVID MODICA: Present. JOHN ROMANO: Can you please state your 14 15 name for the record, please? DAVID MODICA: David Modica, M-o-d-i-c-16 17 a. 18 JOHN ROMANO: Thank you, Dave. Is anybody here representing the 19 20 municipality where the sign is being proposed? 21 (No response.) 22 JOHN ROMANO: Are there any abutters 23 present today? 24 (No response.)

1 JOHN ROMANO: Is there anybody here from the MassHighway District Office? 2 3 (No response.) 4 JOHN ROMANO: We got no memo from the 5 Highway District on this? LYDIA QUIRK: We did not. 6 7 JOHN ROMANO: Thanks, Lydia. Is there anybody present from MassDOT 8 9 Traffic Operations? 10 (No response.) JOHN ROMANO: So, we did not -- they 11 are not present. However, we did -- Mr. Modica, we 12 13 did receive a memo from the Assistant Administrator of Traffic and Safety Engineering, Neil Boudreau. 14 His 15 staff did review this location. And it was determined by them that a traffic study -- a detailed traffic 16 17 study of this location will not be required. 18 DAVID MODICA: Thank you. JOHN ROMANO: Mr. Modica, was certified 19 20 mail notice to abutters sent out by you at least 30 21 days prior to submitting your application to my 22 office? 23 DAVID MODICA: Yes, sir. 24 JOHN ROMANO: And you did provide me a

1 copy of that letter, and I have it with the package. 2 So, thank you. 3 DAVID MODICA: Yes. 4 JOHN ROMANO: And I also have the post 5 office receipts as well, so I appreciate you providing 6 those also, which you have. 7 DAVID MODICA: Yes. JOHN ROMANO: Okay. Did you receive 8 9 any written comments in support or opposition of this 10 application? DAVID MODICA: I have two letters of 11 12 support from abutters, the Dunkin' Donut Corporation, 13 and it wasn't quite -- it was a letter of -- it was okay with them. They had no -- Boston Mutual, which 14 15 is another abutter next door. Other than that, we 16 have received nothing at all negative. 17 JOHN ROMANO: Did you provide those 18 letters to us? DAVID MODICA: I believe I did, sir, 19 20 yes. JOHN ROMANO: I think I have those. 21 22 Boston Mutual Life Insurance, right, 120 Royall 23 Street? 24 DAVID MODICA: Yes, sir.

JOHN ROMANO: And Dunkin' Donuts Brands 1 -- Dunkin' Brands -- got to get that right -- 130 2 3 Royall Street, right? DAVID MODICA: Yes, those are the two. 4 5 JOHN ROMANO: Okay. We have those. Thank you. 6 7 JOHN ROMANO: Thank you. Okay. And then -- and you received an 8 authorization by the town by special permit as signed 9 10 off by the town administrator on your application, is that correct? 11 12 DAVID MODICA: It is correct, yes. Ιt was resolved on the 12<sup>th</sup> of September or thereabouts. 13 JOHN ROMANO: And we did receive that 14 15 special permit as part of your package and we did review that. So, thank you for providing that as 16 17 well. Do you have anything you'd like to add 18 to your application at this time? 19 20 DAVID MODICA: No, no. 21 JOHN ROMANO: Okay. 22 DAVID MODICA: Approval would be nice. 23 JOHN ROMANO: All right. I'm going to 24 have my field inspector, Mr. Chris Chaves, give his

1 field report at this time. CHRISTOPHER CHAVES: Thank you, John. 2 As you mentioned, this is a two-sided 3 4 electronic proposed monopole located at 150 Royall 5 Street in Canton facing Route 128 and I-95. There are multiple businesses within 500 feet of this location 6 7 to meet the criteria. There are no parks, recreational areas within 300 feet. It is situated 8 9 within a ramp. As you know, Mr. Director, this is a 10 unique ramp. We asked for assistance from the State Traffic Engineer regarding this location. 11 It's my 12 understanding that you have a memo regarding the ramp. 13 JOHN ROMANO: That's correct, the State Traffic Engineer. This was one, as we run into more 14 15 of these, it's very difficult for us sometimes to determine Point C, as we all refer to, in determining 16 17 the location. We go to the State Traffic Engineer for 18 their assistance in many instances. And, in this case, this was the case. And the State Traffic 19 20 Engineer reviewed it and provided us where Point C 21 was. And, thus, we were able to determine that this 22 is outside of that location, the 500 feet by Federal 23 Highway, and this does meet that requirement based on the information provided us from the State Traffic 24

And we have that. 2 CHRISTOPHER CHAVES: Yes, sir. 3 There are no other components or issues with this site. 4 5 JOHN ROMANO: It meets all of the CMR 6 requirements? 7 CHRISTOPHER CHAVES: Yes, it does. JOHN ROMANO: From the field 8 9 perspective? CHRISTOPHER CHAVES: From the field 10 11 perspective, yes, sir. 12 JOHN ROMANO: Okay. Anything else to 13 add, Mr. Chaves? 14 CHRISTOPHER CHAVES: No. Thank you. 15 JOHN ROMANO: Any comments, questions, concerns, from the audience? 16 17 (No response.) 18 JOHN ROMANO: Okay. Seeing none, we will take this under advisement and we will get back 19 20 to you. 21 Thank you, Mr. Modica. 22 Thank you. DAVID MODICA: 23 JOHN ROMANO: Okay. The next item under the agenda is application for renewal of Outdoor 24

Office of Outdoor Advertising January 9, 2020 Advertising Permits. There is a list of a bunch. Also unlicensed Outdoor Advertising Permits, a handful of those and the dates they were processed. Any comments or questions on those? (No response.) JOHN ROMANO: Seeing none. Item 4, for the record, actions taken since the last public hearing. Any questions on those? (No response.) JOHN ROMANO: Seeing none. Any public comment in general? (No response.) JOHN ROMANO: None. With that, we are adjourned. Thank you all very much. Happy New Year. (Whereupon, the proceedings were concluded on January 9, 2020 at 11:12 a.m.)
