3	JOHN ROMANO: Good morning, everybody.
4	My name is John Romano. And I am the Director of
5	Outdoor Advertising for MassDOT. We are here for the
6	January $14^{\text{th}}$ Office of Outdoor Advertising hearing.
7	This meeting is being held virtually by
8	Governor's Executive Order. Due to the COVID-19
9	pandemic, we cannot meet in person, so we are doing
10	this virtually as we have been doing since April.
11	We are running this hearing by
12	GoToWebinar.
13	Please note that this meeting is being
14	recorded by our stenographer who is in attendance. He
15	will provide a transcript of the meeting as always,
16	and it will be posted to our web page once the meeting
17	notes are approved at the next meeting.
18	This meeting is accessible to people
19	with disabilities and individuals with limited English
20	proficiency. If you filed a request for assistance

3	meeting. The links for those documents are also
4	available in the chat box, and the materials will also
5	be available to download through GoToWebinar.
6	We are going to run this meeting as
7	close to normal as our regular meetings. I will go
8	through the agenda. While the sign-in sheet cannot be
9	physically signed, we will have a list of those who
10	signed up for the webinar.
11	On the screen will be the agenda.
12	Gerry, if you could post that up the
13	agenda on the screen?
14	GERARD KELLEHER: Yeah.
15	JOHN ROMANO: What we will do is I will
16	go through each item. I will ask questions of the
17	proponents, just like I do in the hearing at the
18	office in person at 10 Park Plaza.
19	Just so you know, everybody in the
20	public is currently muted. In about two minutes, the
21	organizer is going to unmute everyone, and you should
22	mute yourself at that time. Should the organizer, who
23	is Gerry Kelleher from MassDOT, hear excessive
24	background noise, he will mute people individually or

1 the whole group if needed.

If you would like to speak when public comment is requested, you can unmute yourself at that time. If you have any trouble unmuting yourself to make a comment, you can use the raise your hand function in GoToWebinar in order to indicate you would like to make a comment. To raise your hand in GoToWebinar, click the hand icon in the control panel. If you are connected by phone to the audio, you can press \*9 to raise your hand. On the phone, you can also press \*1 to play the features menu and \*2 to mute or unmute the audio.

You can also post your comment or question in the chat box. You will have a chance to make comments just like you do in the regular public hearing at the end of each item and then a final chance for overall comments at the end of the agenda.

For anyone who may be new, we do not make any decisions at this actual hearing. Every item is taken under advisement and decisions are made usually within a few weeks, sometimes as early as a week or sooner, but we will give time for write-in comments to our email address, which is OOAInformation@dot.state.ma.us. 2	With that, Gerry, if you could unmute
3	everybody, we will begin.
4	(Participants unmuted.)
5	JOHN ROMANO: So, if you could scroll
6	down to the second page, Gerry, of the agenda.
7	GERARD KELLEHER: Okay.
8	JOHN ROMANO: We already talked about
9	the sign-in sheet.
10	The minutes approval from the December
11	10, 2020 OOA Public Hearing, the regular session
12	minutes. Does anybody have any questions or comments
13	on those minutes from last meeting?
14	(No response.)
15	JOHN ROMANO: Do you see anyone, Gerry?
16	GERARD KELLEHER: No.
17	JOHN ROMANO: Okay. I don't see any
18	hands raised. I don't hear any comments. So, we will
19	mark those approved.
20	Okay. Next, we have an application for
21	a new license. It is Von Hillern Donovan, LLC, 339
22	Dorchester Street, Boston.
23	We did receive a couple of phone calls
24	this morning. Please note that these are the next

1	two items are just licenses to do business in the
2	state and for outdoor advertising. These are not
3	permits for any signs in case anybody was not sure
4	about that.
5	So, is there anybody here representing
6	Von Hillern Donovan, LLC?
7	(No response.)
8	JOHN ROMANO: Okay. They are not
9	required to attend. But, we have reviewed all of the
10	paperwork. All of the paperwork is in order. We have
11	the proper W9, proper application. We have the proper
12	Certificate of Good Standing and/or Tax Compliance,
13	and we received the appropriate fee.
14	From a paperwork standpoint and meeting
15	the regulation as far as filling everything out and
16	submitting it, we see no issues at this time.
17	Does anybody have any questions on this
18	application?
19	(No response.)
20	JOHN ROMANO: I don't see any hands
21	raised.
22	Gerry, do you see anybody?
23	GERARD KELLEHER: There's one question.
24	Do they have a location yet for a permit? That's not

1	why they're here, right?
2	JOHN ROMANO: That's not I mean this
3	is only for a license for them to do business. You
4	are required to obtain a license first before you can
5	submit any application for a permit. So, they may
6	have one in mind, but it's not something that we have
7	or we're aware of at this time because we do not have
8	we would not require it at this time. They cannot
9	submit a permit request until they are first given a
10	license. So, at this time, we do not have that nor
11	would we accept any of that.
12	Does that answer the question? Are
13	there any other questions?
14	GERARD KELLEHER: Yeah, there's another
15	question. Do we are we going to post contact
16	information for their counsel? That's a question from
17	Adam Sarbaugh.
18	JOHN ROMANO: No, I don't we
19	wouldn't post we don't require them to give us the
20	name of a lawyer or anything like that.
21	GERARD KELLEHER: Okay.
22	JOHN ROMANO: I don't know that they
23	have a lawyer representing them for this or not.
24	That's not a requirement.

1	GERARD KELLEHER: Okay.
2	JOHN ROMANO: Any other questions?
3	GERARD KELLEHER: Karen Foley from the
4	City Councilor's Office is having trouble hearing it,
5	but she left her email address.
6	JOHN ROMANO: Did you say which City
7	Councilor's Office?
8	GERARD KELLEHER: Annissa Essaibi-
9	George.
10	JOHN ROMANO: Oh, okay. Yeah. Because
11	I had contact with Councilor Frank Baker this morning.
12	GERARD KELLEHER: Okay.
13	JOHN ROMANO: Okay. Just to be clear,
14	this is not for a permit. This is only for a license
15	to do business in the state of Massachusetts. And we
16	will take this under advisement and we will get back
17	to the proponent next week.
18	Any other questions on this before I
19	move on?
20	GERARD KELLEHER: I don't have any more
21	at this time.
22	JOHN ROMANO: Okay. So, we will take
23	this under advisement.
24	So, the next also application for a

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1	license is American Outdoor Advertising Company, MA,
2	LLC, 233 Puritan Road, Swampscott, MA.
3	Is there anybody here representing the
4	applicant?
5	(No response.)
6	JOHN ROMANO: Okay. I don't hear any
7	at this time.
8	So, again, just like the previous one,
9	we reviewed all of the paperwork. The application is
10	correct. We have the appropriate certificates, W9,
11	and the Certificate of Good Standing, the appropriate
12	payments.
13	Again, this is just an application for
14	a license in order to do business for outdoor
15	advertising in the state of Massachusetts. It is not
16	a permit in any way, shape, or form.
17	Does anybody have any questions about
18	this particular application?
19	GERARD KELLEHER: I'm not seeing any
20	here.
21	JOHN ROMANO: Okay. All right. With
22	no questions, we will take this one under advisement

4	have one more question came in.
5	JOHN ROMANO: Sure.
6	GERARD KELLEHER: It's from David
7	Hoffman. Is this the same company as Item D.1.?
8	JOHN ROMANO: They are similar
9	companies, but it's a different it's in
10	Massachusetts. I believe the other company is
11	incorporated in a different state. I don't have that
12	in front of me. But they are the same basically
13	the same people, but it's a different, you know,
14	different company though, different places, yeah.
15	Okay. Any other questions?
16	GERARD KELLEHER: No.
17	JOHN ROMANO: Okay. So, I'm going to
18	move on to application for electronic permits. The
19	first application for an electronic permit is Murray
20	Outdoor. It is located at 145 Millbury Street in
21	Worcester. These are existing this is an existing
22	static permit. The existing permit number is 98023.
23	Notification was sent to the city
24	manager and city clerk by my office on 12/8/20.

1	Is the applicant present?
2	JOSEPH MURRAY: Joseph Murray, if you
3	can hear me.
4	GERARD KELLEHER: Yes.
5	JOHN ROMANO: How are you doing, Mr.
6	Murray? Good morning.
7	JOSEPH MURRAY: Good morning.
8	JOHN ROMANO: Is there anybody here
9	representing the municipality where the sign is
10	proposed?
11	(No response.)
12	JOHN ROMANO: Gerry, I don't see any
13	comments. Do you see any comments?
14	GERARD KELLEHER: No, no comments.
15	JOHN ROMANO: Okay. Are there any
16	abutters present today?
17	(No response.)
18	GERARD KELLEHER: Negative.
19	JOHN ROMANO: Negative. I'm not seeing
20	anything.
21	GERARD KELLEHER: Okay.
22	JOHN ROMANO: Is anybody present from
23	the MassHighway District Office the Highway Office?
24	(No response.)

1	JOHN ROMANO: I don't have an email.
2	Traffic Operations I believe our
3	traffic people said that no traffic study will be
4	needed for this one.
5	Am I correct on that, Lydia?
6	LYDIA QUICK: Correct. Yes, John.
7	Sorry.
8	JOHN ROMANO: That's okay. No problem.
9	I have too many pieces of paper here.
10	LYDIA QUICK: There was no traffic
11	study required.
12	JOHN ROMANO: No study required. Okay.
13	Mr. Murray, was certified mail notice
14	to abutters sent out by you at least 30 days prior to
15	submitting your application to my office?
16	JOSEPH MURRAY: Yes, it was. And
17	copies of all the receipts were sent with the
18	application.
19	JOHN ROMANO: Okay. Yes, and I do have
20	the post office receipts and I do have a copy of the
21	letter that you sent. So, thank you.
22	Have you received any comments in
23	support or opposition to this application?
24	JOSEPH MURRAY: No, we haven't received

1	anything at all.
2	JOHN ROMANO: Okay. And we have not
3	either.
4	Mr. Murray, a special permit was issued
5	by the City of Worcester in regards to this, is that
6	correct?
7	JOSEPH MURRAY: Yes, they thoroughly
8	reviewed it and they were pretty meticulous about the
9	abutting businesses nearby. And they scrutinized it
10	pretty carefully and felt that it was a good
11	alteration.
12	JOHN ROMANO: And I do have a copy of
13	that special permit from the City of Worcester. And I
14	believe, if I am correct, I actually had a discussion
15	with them. Yeah, I did speak with them over at Land
16	and Zoning, and they were fine with your application.
17	JOSEPH MURRAY: Okay.
18	JOHN ROMANO: There was a question on
19	the application that I had to double-check with them.
20	They were very good and got back to me right away and
21	everything is in order. So, thank you.
22	With that, I will ask my field
23	inspector, Jason Bean, to give his field report on
24	this location.

1	JASON BEAN: Yeah, if you could share
2	my screen, Gerry?
3	GERARD KELLEHER: Yeah, sure. Hold on
4	a second. Do you have it?
5	JASON BEAN: Yeah.
6	GERARD KELLEHER: Okay.
7	JASON BEAN: Thank you, John.
8	This is a Murray Outdoor permit
9	application for an existing sign. The Application
10	Number is 2021D001. It's an existing double-sided
11	static billboard running east and west on 290 in
12	Worcester.
13	Murray Outdoor is proposing to convert
14	their east-facing sign, which is Permit Number 98023,
15	to a digital sign. It was reviewed in the field.
16	Some measurements were taken. And, at this point,
17	there are no issues with the application currently.
18	JOHN ROMANO: Okay. Great. Jason,
19	thank you very much.
20	Mr. Murray, is there anything you would
21	like to add to your application at this time?
22	
	JOSEPH MURRAY: Not that I can think
23	JOSEPH MURRAY: Not that I can think of, but I'm happy to answer any questions or address

1	JOHN ROMANO: Okay. Great. Does
2	anybody in the general public that's in attendance
3	have any questions or comments on this application?
4	(No response.)
5	GERARD KELLEHER: Not seeing anything.
6	JOHN ROMANO: You don't see any? No?
7	Okay. Great.
8	Mr. Murray, we will take this one under
9	advisement and get back to you.
10	Not that you can go too far, but don't
11	go too far. We have another one for Murray Outdoor.
12	Next is 38-42 Harlow Street in
13	Worcester. This is also an application for an
14	electronic permit. These are Applications sorry.
15	Hold on one second. Let me make the swap over here.
16	These are applications 2021D002 and
17	D003. The existing static permits are 80156 and
18	80157. These two boards will also be moved roughly 75
19	feet to the south of the existing board but on the
20	same property.
21	Notice was sent on 12/15/20 to the city
22	manager and the city clerk by my office. I know these
23	questions are repetitive, but is the applicant
24	present?

1	JOSEPH MURRAY: Yes. Joe Murray,
2	again.
3	JOHN ROMANO: Is there anybody here
4	representing the municipality where the sign is
5	proposed?
6	(No response.)
7	JOHN ROMANO: Hearing none.
8	Are there any abutters to this location
9	present today?
10	(No response.)
11	JOHN ROMANO: Hearing none.
12	Is anyone present from the District
13	Office?
14	(No response.)
15	JOHN ROMANO: So, Joe, just so you
16	know, Chris Chambers, who works at the MassHighway
17	District, one of the engineers there, is, you know,
18	making you aware that should you need any type of
19	access permits for any type of tree-trimming, or
20	cutting, or anything of that nature, it's to be done
21	directly through the District Office. And, you know,
22	you can contact them as soon as as soon as you're
23	ready. You know, any of that, you know, is a separate
24	permit. You know, those permits are separate from us.

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1	So, contact Chris Chambers there if you need to get
2	something.
3	JOSEPH MURRAY: I'm not sure what that
4	entails. I thought we could directly access site.
5	JOHN ROMANO: If you need any tree-
6	trimming or stuff that's on state property, then
7	you'll need an access permit from the District.
8	That's separate from this application. I'm not saying
9	that you need that, but should you need it.
10	JOSEPH MURRAY: Thank you.
11	JOHN ROMANO: Is anyone present from
12	MassDOT Traffic Operations?
13	(No response.)
14	JOHN ROMANO: This one here, we also
15	received a memo I believe that there are no traffic
16	studies required on this as well. I'm just double-
17	checking. Lydia, that's correct, right?
18	LYDIA QUICK: That's correct. Correct,
19	John. No traffic study was required.
	oom. No crarric scudy was required.
20	JOHN ROMANO: Mr. Murray, same set of
20 21	
	JOHN ROMANO: Mr. Murray, same set of
21	JOHN ROMANO: Mr. Murray, same set of questions here. Was certified mail notice to abutters

1	sent copies of receipts with the application.
2	JOHN ROMANO: We do have the post
3	office receipts and we do have a copy of your letter
4	as well. Thank you.
5	Have you received any written comments
6	in support or opposition to this application?
7	JOSEPH MURRAY: No, we haven't received
8	anything at all, and I don't know if the City has
9	either.
10	JOHN ROMANO: We have not either.
11	Again, a special permit was required
12	from the City of Worcester. And that's something you
13	obtained and submitted with your application, correct?
14	JOSEPH MURRAY: That's correct.
15	JOHN ROMANO: We do have a copy and
16	we've reviewed that.
17	Again, like the other one, I did speak
18	with the town and they had no issues.
19	With this, I'm going to turn it back
20	over to Jason and have him give his field report.
21	JASON BEAN: Yeah, thank you, John.
22	Currently, this is 80157 and 80156 is
23	the existing structure at the site. This application

is 2021D002 and 03. They are proposing to build that

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1	75 feet south of 80157 and 80156. The structure will
2	be facing east and west on 290 in Worcester.
3	At this point, some measurements were
4	taken, the documents reviewed, and there are no issues
5	currently with the application.
6	Just one side note, and I forgot to
7	mention it for the prior application. So, 80157 and
8	80156 would need to be surrendered before if they
9	get approved, would need to be surrendered before the
10	new application gets built. So, obviously, with the
11	previous one as well; 98023 on the previous
12	application for Murray Outdoor would have to be
13	surrendered as well.
14	So, currently, there are no issues.
15	And the site was marked properly. It's kind of
16	it's a little difficult to see in the picture, but you
17	can see a cursor. It's right there, marked with a
18	stake marked "billboard."
19	And that's it. Thank you.
20	JOHN ROMANO: Thank you, Jason.
21	So, Joe, you have to first submit to us
22	surrender forms for all three of those boards. And we
23	will not you know, I won't surrender one without
24	issuing the new ones. But I, you know, can't have two

1	permits open for the same board. So, send those
2	surrender forms in. And if and when we approve these
3	permits, one will get surrendered, one will be active.
4	But it won't be a case where you get surrendered and
5	then you don't have other permits. We do them
6	together. But if you could get that into our office,
7	you know, as soon as possible, that would be great.
8	JOSEPH MURRAY: So prior to the I'm
9	sorry prior to the issuance of the actual OOA
10	permit?
11	JOHN ROMANO: Yes.
12	JOSEPH MURRAY: Okay.
13	JOHN ROMANO: You won't be without a
14	permit at any time. That won't happen.
15	JOSEPH MURRAY: Okay.
16	JOHN ROMANO: Obviously, on the first
17	one, you're just switching one you're switching
18	heads. So, you know, when you switch the head, you'll
19	have the new one.
20	This one I know you're building, so if
21	you let us know when the other one before is turned
22	off, we'll do the swap from the static to the digital.
23	JOSEPH MURRAY: Okay.
24	JOHN ROMANO: All right?

1	JOSEPH MURRAY: Very good.
2	JOHN ROMANO: Does anybody have any
3	questions, comments, or concerns from the general
4	public about this location?
5	(No response.)
6	GERARD KELLEHER: Negative.
7	JOHN ROMANO: Okay. Great. We will
8	take these under advisement, Mr. Murray, and we will
9	get back to you. Thank you for your help.
10	JOSEPH MURRAY: Thank you very much.
11	JOHN ROMANO: Okay. Next on the agenda
12	we have Carroll Advertising, LLC. This is the permit
13	number is 2020D007 and D008. This is at excuse me.
14	I apologize. Back up. It's 84-86 Taunton Street in
15	Plainville, MA. These are applications 2021D004 and
16	D005. This is for a new structure, two-sided digital.
17	Notification was sent on December 15 <sup>th</sup>
18	to the town manager and the town clerk by my office.
19	Is the applicant present?
20	JOHN CARROLL: Yes, John Carroll is
21	here.
22	JOHN ROMANO: Good morning, Mr.
23	Carroll.
24	JOHN CARROLL: Good morning.

1	JOHN ROMANO: Is there anyone here
2	representing the municipality where the sign is being
3	proposed?
4	(No response.)
5	JOHN ROMANO: None.
6	Are there any abutters present today?
7	(No response.)
8	JOHN ROMANO: I don't see or hear
9	anybody. Gerry, anything? No?
10	GERARD KELLEHER: No, I'm not seeing
11	anything.
12	JOHN ROMANO: Okay. So, Mr. Carroll,
13	the District Traffic Office District Highway
14	Office, I'm sorry, Bill Travers said he had no issues
15	with this. They're all set on the Highway Traffic
16	District Office.
17	MassDOT Traffic Operations, I did, as I
18	had notified you, I did receive from the state traffic
19	engineer's office their assessment and a memo, which I
20	will get you. They reviewed the site and here is
21	their comment for this location.
22	The proposed is to construct a new
23	structure for this digital board on the east side of
24	Route 1 facing southbound traffic. It also applies to

1	the northbound section of four-lane undivided highway
2	at the street alignment near Route 1 and Route 152
3	intersection. Minimum distractions have been seen.
4	However, the proposed billboard did not meet the
5	minimum 500 feet from the intersection.
6	Based on these observations, it is our
7	judgment that a detailed traffic study at this
8	location will be needed.
9	So, when they say the minimum 500 feet,
10	that's them doing their traffic analysis, not anything
11	to do with our 500 feet spacing or anything like that.
12	So, you will be required to do a
13	traffic study for this location before we can issue a
14	permit. We will get you all of the appropriate
15	paperwork for that. The way that will work is there's
16	an additional study that needs to be done. Once that
17	is done and approved by our traffic people, then we
18	would be able to issue the permit, if that's done to
19	their satisfaction and approval.
20	And then there is a follow-up one-year
21	study that needs to be done after the board is
22	installed.
23	So, there's a pre-installation study
24	and a post-installation study. We have a package that

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1	we will send you to give you all of the materials.
2	So, Mr. Carroll, was certified mail
3	notice to abutters sent out at least 30 days prior to
4	submitting your application to my office?
5	JOHN CARROLL: Yes, sir.
6	JOHN ROMANO: And I do have copies of
7	the post office receipts and I do have a copy of the
8	letter that you sent out. So, thank you.
9	Have you received written any comments
10	in support or opposition to this proposed billboard?
11	JOHN CARROLL: No, sir.
12	JOHN ROMANO: And neither have we.
13	And, also, a special permit was
14	required by the Town of Plainville. And you have
15	submitted that, received and submitted that special
16	permit, is that correct?
17	JOHN CARROLL: Yes, sir.
18	JOHN ROMANO: And I do have a copy of
19	that permit.
20	Mr. Carroll, at this time, is there
21	anything you'd like to add to your application?
22	JOHN CARROLL: No, sir.
23	JOHN ROMANO: With that, I am going to
24	have Marc Plante, my inspector, give his report on the

1	location.
2	Marc, whenever you're ready. Marc,
3	you're on mute.
4	GERARD KELLEHER: I have to switch over
5	to him.
6	JOHN ROMANO: All right. Hold on.
7	MARC PLANTE: How am I doing now?
8	GERARD KELLEHER: Okay, Marc.
9	MARC PLANTE: Okay?
10	GERARD KELLEHER: You're in control.
11	MARC PLANTE: Very good. Thanks,
12	Gerry.
13	This is an application for a new
14	monopole in the Town of Plainville on Route 1. It's
15	two-panel digital, one facing north, one facing south.
16	The area has two businesses within 500 feet. There
17	are no park, recreation, playgrounds within 300 feet
18	of the area. And there is no spacing issue. So, the
19	application is conforming to these regulations.
20	JOHN ROMANO: Great. Thank you, Marc.
21	Appreciate that.
22	Does anyone have any comments,
23	questions, concerns from the general public on this
24	application these applications?

1	(No response.)
2	JOHN ROMANO: I'm not seeing anything
3	or hearing any.
4	Gerry?
5	GERARD KELLEHER: I don't see anything.
6	JOHN ROMANO: Okay. Great. All right.
7	Mr. Carroll, we will take these under advisement. We
8	will get you the information next week on the traffic
9	study requirements. Okay?
10	JOHN CARROLL: Thank you.
11	JOHN ROMANO: Next up on the agenda,
12	Carroll Outdoor Advertising, LLC, again. This is for
13	just an amendment to existing permits, Permit Number
14	2020D007 and D008. This is at 3 Lopes Drive in
15	Norton. Again, this is an existing digital. And the
16	board is the request in the amendment is to move
17	the board 50 feet on the same property.
18	So, we received the appropriate
19	paperwork signed off by the Town of Norton. They
20	didn't have any issues with the movement of the
21	location, or movement of the board on the location.
22	So, Mr. Carroll, just to let you know,
23	we did have our traffic people review this. And no
24	traffic study is needed for this, nor was there one

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1	for the original erection. So, they determined that
2	even, you know, the movement of this, you won't have
3	to do any further traffic analysis.
4	We did get a special permit from the
5	Town on this. You did submit that. So, that is
6	correct, right?
7	JOHN CARROLL: Yes, sir.
8	JOHN ROMANO: So, as far as from a
9	paperwork standpoint, a little different than a new
10	application, but everything seems to be in order.
11	However, Marc, if you could give me your inspector's
12	report on this as well, that would be great.
13	MARC PLANTE: Yes, John.
14	Existing in the Town of Norton facing
15	Route 495. It is to be moved 50 feet to the
16	northeast. It will not affect the business situation.
17	No parks, playgrounds, recreation areas within 300
18	feet. So, no spacing issues with any other signs.
19	So, the only note I want to make, and
20	it is behind the fencing, chain link fence, which
21	denotes the state highway layout, which is fine. I

3	JOHN ROMANO: Thanks, Marc.
4	Mr. Carroll, you understood what Marc
5	was explaining about the state layout lines?
6	JOHN CARROLL: Yes, sir.
7	JOHN ROMANO: Okay. Fine.
8	Does anybody have any comments,
9	questions, or concerns about this amendment to the
10	existing permit at 3 Lopes Drive in Norton?
11	(No response.)
12	JOHN ROMANO: Okay. Seeing none. We
13	will take this under advisement.
14	Just a note both to Mr. Murray an to
15	Mr. Carroll. As I am sure you are well aware, you've
16	both done digital boards with us before, should this
17	be approved, you know, there is a 15-hour-a-month
18	public service announcement requirement. Mr. Kelleher
19	will coordinate with your contacts. They're
20	especially not that they're not always important,
21	but, you know, these last eight to ten months with
22	COVID-19 pandemic, we've used the boards to get a lot
23	of information out about the pandemic and staying safe
24	from it in general. While it's always an important

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1	program, it's more important over the last ten months.
2	So, just a reminder of that.
3	And, you know, Section 3.17 of the
4	regulations is all of the electronic requirements, you
5	know, as far as the static display change times and
6	all of those things. So, I'm just reminding you and
7	telling you those if you don't know. That's all.
8	With that, we'll take that amendment
9	under advisement. Thank you, Mr. Carroll.
10	MR. CARROLL: Thank you. Appreciate
11	it.
12	JOHN ROMANO: On to the rest of the
13	agenda. The next items here are Item D and E are both
14	renewals of Outdoor Advertising licenses, permits, and
15	unlicensed permits for 2021. These are all existing.
16	No new locations, just a renewal, annual renewals that
17	we do at this time of year.
18	Does anybody have any comments or
19	questions about those?
20	(No response.)
21	JOHN ROMANO: Okay. Seeing none. We
22	will move onto the For the Record part of the
23	application, actions taken since our last public
24	hearing. Basically, two licenses were approved.

4	JOHN ROMANO: Okay. Seeing none.
5	The last item on the agenda, public
6	comment. Does anybody have any other public comment
7	in regards to anything on today's agenda or anything
8	just in general?
9	(No response.)
10	JOHN ROMANO: Okay. Seeing none. Ever
11	though it's listed twice, we're only going to give you
12	one opportunity to comment.
13	So, that's all I have. Thank you all
14	very much. This hearing is adjourned. Thank you all
15	for attending.

17	to you in a short period of time.
