

In service beds are taken out of service for an indefinite period of time with no plan to put the beds back into service.





^{*}Potential exception: Per 105 CMR 153.028(F), closing an entire unit for any period of time must be treated as a permanent reduction in the number of beds on the facility license. However, if there are exceptional circumstances necessitating closure of the unit for a finite period of time during which the beds in the unit will need to be out of service, and there is the intent to reopen the unit and return the beds to service when those circumstances no longer exist, then prior to closing the unit the facility licensee may request permission from the Department to treat those beds as beds temporarily out of service rather than as beds permanently out of service.
