Consideration of a Tentative Decision in the matter of **New England Power Company d/b/a National Grid, EFSB 23-02/D.P.U. 23-45**, a request pursuant to G.L. c. 164, §§ 69J, 72, to replace an existing double circuit transmission line, tap lines, and structures with a new double circuit overhead transmission line, tap lines, and structures in an existing transmission corridor in Warwick, Royalston, Athol, Winchendon, Gardner, Westminster, Fitchburg, Leominster, and Sterling, Massachusetts.
