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
change in the category of deaths that are included. Death data that were previously reported as "Unintentional/Undetermined" has been updated to include deaths of "All Intents", which means that opioid-related deaths that have been determined by the Office of the Chief Medical Examiner as the result of suicide will now be included in the totals. This will not add significantly to the death totals, however it will allow for consistency in interpretation in the data that are presented.

This data brief highlights demographic data from confirmed opioid-related overdose deaths for all intents, from January 2016 to December 2016.


All Intents Opioids Deaths by Gender




Deaths by Race
