**CONSENT AGREEMENT FOR REPRIMAND**

The Massachusetts Board of Registration in Pharmacy (“Board”) and Optum Infusion Services 550, LLC located at 20 Commerce Way, Suite 2 in Woburn (“Pharmacy” or “Licensee”), a pharmacy licensed by the Board, license number DS90100, do hereby stipulate and agree that the following information shall be entered into and become a permanent part of the Pharmacy’s record maintained by the Board:

1. The Pharmacy acknowledges the Board opened two Complaints against its Massachusetts pharmacy license related to the conduct set forth in Paragraph 2, identified as Docket Number PHA-2023-0196 and PHA-2023-0239 (“Complaints”).
2. The Pharmacy and the Board agree to resolve the Complaints without making any admissions or findings and without proceeding to a formal adjudicatory hearing. The Complaints allege the following:
  - a. The Pharmacy failed to timely submit mandatory biannual sterile compounding reports from July 2020 through December 2022.
  - b. During a sterile compounding inspection on October 18, 2023, a Board investigator discovered insanitary conditions including a recurring water leak over a five-month period; remedial microbiological sampling was continually delayed due to unavailability of equipment and trained personnel during the period of the water leak; and the Pharmacy failed to report AAL results of a highly pathogenic microorganism.
3. The Board and Licensee acknowledge and agree that based upon the information described in Paragraph 2 the Board could find the Licensee in violation of 247 CMR 6.15 (5) and (7), BORP Policy 2019-08, BORP Policy 2023-09 and the recognized standards of practice warranting disciplinary action by the Board under M.G.L. c. 112, §§ 42A and 61, 247 CMR 10.03(1)(a).

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4. The Pharmacy agrees that the Board shall impose a REPRIMAND on its license based on the facts described in Paragraph 2, effective as of the date on which the Board signs this Agreement (“Effective Date”).
5. The Board agrees that in return for the Pharmacy’s execution and successful compliance with all the requirements of this Agreement, the Board will not prosecute the Complaints.
6. The Pharmacy understands that it has a right to formal adjudicatory hearing concerning the Complaints and that during said adjudication the Pharmacy would possess the right to confront and cross-examine witnesses, to call witnesses, to present evidence, to testify on its own behalf, to contest the allegations, to present oral argument, to appeal to the courts, and all other rights as set forth in the Massachusetts Administrative Procedures Act, M.G.L. c. 30A, and the Standard Adjudicatory Rules of Practice and Procedure, 801 CMR 1.01 *et seq.* The Pharmacy further understands that by executing this Agreement the Pharmacy is knowingly and voluntarily waiving its right to a formal adjudication of the Complaints.
7. The Pharmacy acknowledges that it has been at all times represented by Counsel or otherwise free to seek and use legal counsel in connection with the Complaints and this Agreement.
8. The Pharmacy acknowledges that after the Effective Date, the Agreement constitutes a public record of disciplinary action by the Board subject to the Commonwealth of Massachusetts’ Public Records Law, M.G.L. c. 4, § 7. The Board may forward a copy of this Agreement to other licensing boards, law enforcement entities, and other individuals or entities as required or permitted by law.
9. The Pharmacy understands and agrees that entering into this Agreement is a voluntary and final act and not subject to reconsideration, appeal or judicial review.
10. The individual signing this Agreement certifies that they are authorized to enter into this Agreement on behalf of the Pharmacy, and that they have read this Agreement.
