RE: Elimination of PCC Referral Requirement for Clinical Laboratory Tests

Background

Currently, when a primary care clinician (PCC) refers a plan member to a specialist who then orders clinical laboratory tests, the laboratory must include the member's PCC referral number on the MassHealth claim. This requirement has been a problem for laboratories.

Reduction of Administrative Burden

As part of the Division's efforts to reduce administrative burdens for MassHealth providers, the Division has reviewed the PCC referral policy and has determined that PCC referrals will no longer be required for clinical laboratory services.

Elimination of Referral Requirement

Effective for dates of service beginning December 1, 2001, the Division will no longer require a PCC referral number on claims for payment of clinical laboratory services provided to MassHealth members enrolled in the PCC Plan.
