## **Advisory: Newton, Weston**

### **Overnight Closures of I-90 Ramps**

*Ramp closures will begin on Tuesday, March 18*

**NEWTON/WESTON** – The Massachusetts Department of Transportation (MassDOT) is announcing upcoming closures of the ramps from I-90 eastbound and westbound for vehicular travel to I-95 northbound (Route 128) in Newton and Weston. These ramps will be closed nightly from Tuesday, March 18, through Saturday, March 22.

The closures are as follows:

The ramps from I-90 to I-95 northbound (Route 128) will be closed nightly from 11:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. from Tuesday through Friday, and from 10:30 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. on Friday, March 21, and Saturday, March 22.

Drivers seeking to access I-95 northbound (Route 128) from I-90 eastbound and westbound will be rerouted to I-95 southbound (Route 128), where they can take exit 37 to reverse direction and continue onto I-95 northbound (Route 128).

This closure is necessary for crews to safely conduct construction operations related to the Newton/Weston bridge rehabilitation project at the I-90/I-95 (Route 128) interchange.

Drivers traveling through the affected areas should expect delays, reduce speed, and use caution.

Appropriate signage, law enforcement details, and advanced message boards will be in place to guide drivers through the work area.

All scheduled work is weather dependent and subject to change without notice.
