Overnight Closures of I-95 Northbound Ramp to I-90

Ramp closures will begin on Tuesday, March 18

NEWTON/WESTON – The Massachusetts Department of Transportation (MassDOT) is announcing upcoming closures of the ramp from I-95 northbound (Route 128) exit 39B to I-90 eastbound and westbound in Newton and Weston. This ramp will be closed nightly from Tuesday, March 18, through Saturday, March 22.

The closures are as follows:

The ramp from I-95 northbound (Route 128) to I-90 eastbound and westbound at exit 39B will be closed nightly from 11:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. from Tuesday, March 18, through Friday, March 21, and from 10:30 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. on Friday, March 21, and Saturday, March 22.

Drivers seeking to access I-90 eastbound and westbound from I-95 northbound (Route 128) will be rerouted to I-95 north (Route 128), where they can take exit 41 to reverse direction to I-95 southbound (Route 128) and then exit 39A.

This closure is necessary for crews to safely conduct construction operations related to the Newton/Weston bridge rehabilitation project at the I-90/I-95 (Route 128) interchange.

Drivers traveling through the affected areas should expect delays, reduce speed, and use caution.

Appropriate signage, law enforcement details, and advanced message boards will be in place to guide drivers through the work area.

All scheduled work is weather dependent and subject to change without notice.
