What is Environmental Justice (EJ)?

This term **means that all people should have the ability to live in and enjoy a clean and healthy environment** regardless of race, color, income, class, handicap, gender identity, sexual orientation, national origin, ethnicity or ancestry, religious belief or English language proficiency.

The **goal** of EJ is for **all people to have the right and equal access to these environmental fundamentals**, which include but is not limited to:

What is an EJ Population?

In Massachusetts, an EJ population is a neighborhood where **one or more of the following criteria is true:**



40% of the population comprise of minorities



Community median household income is no more than 65% of statewide annual median household income



25% of the population lack English proficiency



25% of the population comprise of minorities and the household income of the municipality is no more than 150% of the statewide annual median household income

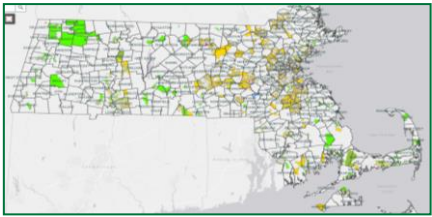
