MassHealth Oxygen and Respiratory Therapy Equipment Bulletin 12 March 2002

RE: New Options for Required Accreditation

Background

The Division is establishing new eligibility requirements for providers of oxygen and respiratory therapy equipment. These requirements will supersede those promulgated in MassHealth Oxygen and Respiratory Therapy Equipment Bulletin 10 of September 1997.

New Accreditation Options

The Division's regulations at 130 CMR 427.404 require oxygen and respiratory therapy equipment providers to be accredited. The regulations currently require that accreditation be through the Joint Commission of Accreditation of Healthcare Organizations (JCAHO), as an oxygen and respiratory therapy equipment provider. As of April 1, 2002, the Division will also accept accreditation by the Community Health Accreditation Program (CHAP) or the Accreditation Commission for Health Care (ACHC).

The regulations will be updated at a later date to reflect this change.

Compliance

As of April 1, 2002, and continuing until further notice, every provider submitting a provider application or reenrollment for participation in MassHealth as a provider of oxygen and respiratory therapy equipment must include documentation of current accreditation by JCAHO, CHAP, or ACHC in addition to all other required documentation.
