Section 26 of Chapter 260 of the Acts of 2020, or the Health Care Omnibus bill establishes a special advisory council, chaired by the Commissioner of the Department of Public Health, or her designee, to advise the commissioner on research, diagnosis, treatment and education relating to pediatric autoimmune neuropsychiatric disorder associated with streptococcal infections and pediatric acute neuropsychiatric syndrome (PANDAS/PANS).

<u>Situation</u>: The advisory council was created in Section 26 (242) of Chapter 260 of the Acts of 2020, or the Health Care Omnibus bill. The Council is slated to report to the DPH Commissioner. To represent the Commissioner as her designee, the Division for Children & Youth with Special Health Needs are most appropriate for this role.

<u>Advisory Council Purpose</u>: Advise the DPH Commissioner on research, diagnosis, <u>treatment</u> and education relating to pediatric autoimmune neuropsychiatric disorder associated with streptococcal infections and pediatric acute neuropsychiatric syndrome (PANDAS/PANS).

<u>Short Term Goal</u>: By January 12, 2022, the Council will have developed a work plan and aim statement to begin its research and writing of its first annual report to the Commissioner.
