The Board of Registration in Pharmacy (Board) is in receipt of your pharmacy technician wallet registration card no. 413841. The Board has previously issued a *Temporary Order of Suspension* regarding your pharmacy technician registration, effective December 14, 2009.

Please be advised that the Board has accepted the surrender of your pharmacy technician registration on the terms and condition that you understand and agree your surrender is voluntarily tendered; that registration surrender is considered to be a disciplinary action depriving you of all privileges of registration; that registration surrender is not subject to reconsideration or judicial review; and that the Board will not review any application for licensure as a pharmacy technician in the future.
