PERAC Appoints General Counsel



General Counsel Judith Corrigan, Esq.

The Public Employee Retirement Administration Commission (PERAC) has selected PERAC Deputy General Counsel and Managing Attorney, Judith Corrigan, Esq. as its next General Counsel.

Attorney Corrigan has been with PERAC for 20 years, starting in 1999 as an Associate General Counsel. During her tenure at PERAC, she has played a key role in the shaping and implementation of PERAC's legal policy. She has tried cases before the Massachusetts Supreme Judicial Court, works collaboratively

with the Massachusetts Office of the Attorney General, and is often invited to speak locally and nationally on the proper administration of public pension systems.

"Judith is a dedicated, knowledgeable, and passionate attorney," PERAC Chairman Phil Brown stated. "I am pleased she was selected to this important position at PERAC from a pool of very qualified candidates."

Prior to coming to PERAC, she served as both staff attorney and senior attorney for the Appalachian Research and Defense Fund of Kentucky (AppalReD), an organization providing legal services to the poor in rural Appalachia.

She currently resides in Allston with her three children, Mary, William, and Grace.
