











PETITION OPPOSING THE REOPENING OF ATTLEBORO LANDFILL, INC.

Mr. Dakers,

I am writing to express my opposition to the Enviro-Cycle, LLC proposal for reopening the Attleboro landfill, Inc. The Conceptual Alternative Closure Plan (The Plan) would use Union Road in Norton to travel to the Attleboro Landfill, Inc. (ALI) located on Peckham Street in Attleboro. The 9,000 trucks using Union Road would affect my quality of life and possibly the health of my family.

Union Road is a narrow street; many of the homes are close to the road and are occupied by families with young children who play in their yards. A number of the homes are occupied by older individuals who care for their grandchildren one or more days of the week. Union road is a popular road for people walking, running and walking their dogs. There are no sidewalks so everyone walks in the narrow street.

ALI is located in Attleboro and any work to be done at that location should use the streets of Attleboro. There is no reason the residents of Norton should be exposed to Construction and Demolition Fines (C&D Fines). C&D fines are primarily crushed gypsum wall board, which contain hydrogen sulfide, Crystalline Silica, and from older homes, remnants of lead based paint. Children at bus stops will be exposed to Crystalline Silica, a known human carcinogen. The "safe" exposure limit for Crystalline Silica has not been determined for adults or children.

I find it difficult to understand why the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection advocates dumping ground wall board in a landfill when US Gypsum, a manufacture of wallboard, advocates recycling the waste product.
