Work continues in North Park and Pilgrim Mother Garden. North Park parking and bus drop off have reopened, but South Park lawn will remain off limits. Fencing delineates the active work area(s). Please follow marked pedestrian routes.

### **South Park**

- Install parking signs.
- Benches and trash barrels return.
- Overseed bare lawn areas.
- Park will remain fenced off until grass is established.

### **Cole's Hill**

- Overseed bare lawn areas.
- Remove silt fence.

### **North Park – Shops Remain Open!**

- Pave walking paths.
- Install and repair irrigation.
- Install loam, seed, and plantings.

### **Pilgrim Mother Fountain / Portico**

- Install loam, seed, and plantings.
- Irrigation and plumbing.
- Repairs to granite seawall at Portico.
- Repairs to retaining wall along Water St.
