- Refurbish Railings & Light Post
- Hydroseeding & Irrigation

North Park – Shops Remain Open!

- Temporary Fence Installation
- Pavement & Sidewalk demolition
- Installation of catch basins
- Subgrade Prep & Curbing

Pilgrim Mother Fountain / Portico

- Temporary Fence Installation
- Demolition & Curbing
- Refurbish Portico Railings
