Guided Tour: Meaning and Monuments

Explore one of America's most remarkable treasures: a monumental granite sculpture celebrating the ideals of the Mayflower passengers.

Towering above Plymouth Harbor, the National Monument to the Forefathers stands as a powerful tribute to the Pilgrims. Join DCR staff for a 30-minute guided walk and discover the rich symbolism carved in stone. Learn about the values this monument represents, and consider what these same values mean to you over 400 years after the Mayflower's arrival.



Free. For adults and ages 10+. Minors must be accompanied by an adult. Ample parking on-site. Meet at the base of the monument, located at 72 Allerton Street in Plymouth. We will walk approximately 0.2 miles on flat, paved surfaces. Be prepared to stand in bright sun. Portable toilets available. In the event of severe weather, call ahead to confirm.
