We have received and reviewed the documents you sent to us on November 10, 2023, in response to our request of November 3, 2023. The Interim Permit dated January 8, 1969, mentions an application from Boston Edison Company, received by the Water Resources Commission on October 17, 1968; a report entitled “Pilgrim Station No. 600, Boston Edison Company, Salt Water Use and Waterfront Development for Pilgrim Nuclear Power Station”; and “operating records pertaining to the treatment of liquid wastes” that were required to be maintained as a condition of the Interim Permit. We would like to provide Holtec the opportunity to further supplement its above-referenced application for modification by supplying any and all of these materials, from 1971 or earlier, that are reflected in Holtec’s records; any other reports, records, studies, maps or information submitted by Boston Edison Company in support of the application for the Interim Permit; and any applications and associated materials related to the three Water Quality Certifications (July 31, 1970, April 15, 1971, and April 23, 1971). Please send any such supplemental materials to my attention by Wednesday, December 20, 2023.
