**SHREEJI KRISHNA LLC D/B/A CHICO'S WINE & SPIRITS

Shreeji Krishna LLC d/b/a Chico's Wine & Spirits (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, § 15. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission ("Commission" or "ABCC") held a hearing on Tuesday, January 7, 2020, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2)- Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. Ch.138 § 34- Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the Licensee stipulated to the facts alleged in Investigator Teehan's Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

1. Investigator Teehan's Compliance Check Field Report;
2. Licensee Stipulation of Fact;
3. Copy of License Transfer Application Approval, 6/20/2017.

There is one (1) audio recording of this hearing.

FACTS

1. On Thursday, August 29, 2019, at approximately 4:55 p.m., Investigators Watson and Teehan ("Investigators") conducted an investigation of the business operation of Shreeji Krishna LLC d/b/a Chico's Wine & Spirits.
2. An underage operative, working with Investigators, purchased from the Licensee an alcoholic beverage, a can Bud Light beer, for two dollars and eighty-five cents (\$2.85). The underage operative was not asked for identification.
3. The Licensee has updated its point-of-sale system requiring employees to scan the identification in order to complete a transaction.
4. The Licensee has held a license under M.G.L. c. 138, § 15 since 2017 with no prior violations.

CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the Licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2)- Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. Ch.138 § 34- Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. The Commission issues a **WARNING**.
