DECISION

MOZZARELLA'S OF PLAINVILLE, INC. DBA FITSY'S PUB 1 MANMAR DRIVE PLAINVILLE, MA 02762 LICENSE#: 097800006

Mozzarella's of Plainville, Inc. dba Fitsy's Pub (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, §12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, May 27, 2014, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2) – Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: c. 138, §34 Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Guarino-Wilichoski's Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

- 1. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts; and
- 2. Investigator Guarino-Wilichoski's Investigative Report dated February 26, 2014.

There is one (1) audio recording of this hearing.

FACTS

- 1. On Wednesday, February 26, 2014 at approximately 6:24 p.m., Investigators Temple and Guarino-Wilichoski conducted an investigation of the business operation of Mozzarella's of Plainville, Inc. dba Fitsy's Pub.
- 2. An underage operative, working with investigators, purchased a glass of Budweiser Light Draught beer for three dollars and sixty-five cents (\$3.65). The underage operative was not asked for identification.

CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2) – Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: c. 138, §34 – Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. Therefore, the Commission suspends the license for three (3) days of which three (3) days will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations occur.
