The petitioner for Boston University is seeking relief from 248 CMR 10.10(15)(C)17.c.III, 10.10(9)(a) to allow the renovation of laundry rooms in a dormitory building with a reduction in the required laundry sinks. The Board of Health and local inspector have been notified.

#### 25-PV-40, Daniel Mcintyre, 50 Grafton Street, Millbury

The petitioner for National Grid is seeking relief from 248 CMR 10.10(15)(c)(19) to allow the construction of a 600 sq ft addition to an equipment enclosure without the required bathroom facilities.
