Members discussed at length the need for over-pressurization protection as outlined in NFPA - 54, 2024 5.8 and decided to leave the section as is, with no amendments.

Counsel indicated he had drafted language regarding plastic venting, however, he noted that there has been a large amount of public interest in this topic and thus suggested there be a formal opportunity for stakeholder input. The members agreed to offer a listening session at the next regular Plumbing Board meeting on August 7th, at 9 a.m. to give the public a chance to comment on the proposed code and their comments about gas venting.

Members decided to meet again on July 31, at 1 p.m. to discuss chapters 7 and 9. Among the topics they intend to discuss are gas valves after the meter, and tracer wire for buried plastic pipes.
