The committee members noted that the existing code utilized the 2012 edition of NFPA 54 and 58. Counsel indicated that the members should consider how these codes have been changed over the years, and should also consider if there are any other codes worth considering, such as NFPA 2 for hydrogen, as well as codes referenced in 248 CMR 7.00, which include NFPA 84, and NFPA 85. As part of this, counsel distributed a link provided by NFPA to allow free public access to its code online.

Members agreed to generally review these codes for the next meeting. No formal action taken.

Board members discussed scheduling and generally indicated a virtual meeting should be planned for January 18, at 1 p.m.
