#### 24-GV-180, Jon Brenton, 600 Terminal E, Boston

The petitioner is seeking relief from 248 CMR 5.1.1(a), Installation of Piping Systems Over 5 million BTU, NFPA 54 5.4.2.1, Maximum Gas Demand, and 248 CMR 7.02(4)a.2 Chimneys, to allow the use of the existing control system to limit boiler operations because gas supply is limited and cannot fire all three boilers at 100%. They also seek permission, to allow the installation of a breaching stack without the required cap. State inspector Padden has been notified. Vote: WT to approve with existing controls, RA seconded Results: Unanimously approved

#### 24-PV-165 through 169, Brian Kubaska, 33 Tafts Avenue, Winthrop

The petitioner for the MWRA is seeking relief from 248 CMR 10.17 Table 2, Size of Vertical Storm Drain Conductors, to allow the retrofit of roof drains that do not meet the maximum roof area specified. This variance is for the following five buildings that are located at the Deer Island Treatment Plant. State inspector O'Reilly has been notified.
