DECISION

MAGGIE'S PUB, INC. DBA GALWAY PUB 58 COURT ST. PLYMOUTH, MA 02360 LICENSE#: 098400007 HEARD: 09/04/2012

Maggie's Pub, Inc. dba Galway Pub (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, §12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, September 4, 2012, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05(2), to wit: c.138, §34. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Binienda's Compliance Check Field Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

- 1. Investigator Binienda's Compliance Check Field Report dated May 14, 2012; and
- 2. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts.

There is one (1) audio recording of this hearing.

FACTS

- 1. On Monday, May 14, 2012, at approximately 6:07 p.m., Investigators Kenny and Binienda conducted an investigation of the business operation of Maggie's Pub, Inc. dba Galway Pub.
- 2. An underage operative working with investigators purchased an alcoholic beverage, a Bud Lite draft beer for two dollars and seventy-five cents (\$2.75). The underage operative was not asked for identification.

CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2), to wit: M.G.L. c. 138, §34. As the licensee has been in business for over ten (10) years and has had no previous violations, the Commission issues a WARNING.
