## **DECISION**

Plymouth Property, LLC dba The British Beer Company (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, §15. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, October 30, 2012, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2) – Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. Ch.138 §34- Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one years of age, according to Investigator Binienda's Compliance Check Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

- 1. Investigator Binienda's Compliance Check Field Report dated May 14, 2012; and
- 2. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts.

The Commission took Administrative Notice of the contents of the file for the license Plymouth Property, LLC dba The British Beer Company, 6 Middle Street., Plymouth, Massachusetts, 02360.

There is one (1) audio recording of this hearing, and one witness testified during the hearing.

## **FACTS**

- 1. On Monday, May 14, 2012, at approximately 6:25 p.m., Investigators Kenny and Binienda conducted an investigation of the business operation of Plymouth Property, LLC dba The British Beer Company.
- 2. An underage operative working with investigators purchased an alcoholic beverage, a bottle of Budweiser Light beer, for three dollars and seventy-five cents (\$3.75). The underage operative was not asked for identification.
- 3. During the course of the hearing, an individual represented himself as an owner of the licensed premises.
- 4. The file indicates that this individual is neither an owner, nor the license manager.

## **CONCLUSION**

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2) - Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. Ch.138 §34- Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one years of age. As the licensee has been in business for ten (10) years and has had no previous violations, the Commission issues a **WARNING**.

The Commission refers this matter to the Investigative and Enforcement Division for all needful and appropriate investigations regarding Plymouth Property, LLC dba The British Beer Company.
