



DCR 2020 Improvements - Project Goals

- Undertake Repairs to Plymouth Rock as an early action item
- Rehabilitate Pilgrim Memorial State Park in advance of the 2020 Celebrations
 - Bathroom Building upgrades and accessibility improvements
 - Landscape rehab including repairs to paths, turf at Amphitheater and accessibility upgrades
 - Conservation of monuments and memorials
- Concurrent partnership project to repair Forefathers Monument



















Scope of Work – Rock Repairs

- Replace concrete ring
- Install four new "thrust blocks"
- New granite shim blocks below Rock
- Repoint joint between two Rock segments

- Cost: \$47,000
- Schedule: June 2017




Path surface and curbing are worn out



Overgrown vegetation

Localized collapse at rip rap



Conservation work needed











Grass is in poor condition

Trees and shrubs need care







Paving in poor condition

Accessible parking can be improved







Plantings and Fountain need rehabilitation

Pilgrim Mother Garden is not universally accessible









Worn out doors and windows

Deterioration of clapboard, roof shingles, gutters and downspouts





Opportunity to improve accessibility and water conservation




Fixtures, flooring and finishes to be updated

Scope of Work - Architecture

- Replace roof, downspouts and gutters
- Replace clapboard siding
- Repair or replace windows
- Upgrade fixtures, finishes and partitions in both restrooms
- Add window in men's room
- Add storage and insulation in DCR Office

Scope of Work - Landscape

- Rehabilitate pathways, adding paving in South Park and restoring failed waterfront areas
- Repair turf and add irrigation at Amphitheater
- Improve circulation and add benches
- Enhance existing vegetation
- Create accessible entry to Pilgrim Mother Garden
- Repair interior paving and iron work at Portico

Next Steps

- Rock Repair and Bronze Conservation by 6/30/17
- Landscape and Building- Finalize design and construction documents by end of June
- Public Meeting to present landscape design June
- Sidewalk repairs June
- 2 Contracts Bid phase July/August
- Construction: Bathroom Building: Winter 2017/2018
