  - The Chair recognized a quorum.
- 2. Discussion of Role of Executive Director
  - The Screening Committee discussed core questions to ask of candidates during screening interviews, relating to each candidate's experience with starting an organization, managing an organizations and working in the public sector.
    - Why does the candidate think they're qualified for the position?
    - Why does their lack of law enforcement experience or law enforcement experience make them more or less qualified for the position?
    - What is their experience with working in a highly public area?
    - What is the most challenging part of the statute to execute?
    - Is there something else the candidate thinks the Commission should know about them?
  - The Screening Committee recognized the difficulties of the Executive Director position they will have many responsibilities and deal with many sensitive topics.
