# C&D MINIMUM PERFORMANCE STANDARD IMPLEMENTATION

# C&D Minimum Performance Standard Goals and Objectives

Simply put...

# Ensure that every ton of C&D material is processed at an MPS-compliant facility

- Recover maximum value from recyclable/re-usable materials
- Separate all waste ban materials
- Minimize tonnage sent for disposal

## **C&D MPS Performance Criteria**

- C&D MPS performance criteria:
  - 1. Achieve a 15% Process Separation Rate (PSR) minimum threshold;
  - 2. Demonstrate that all banned materials are separated to the greatest extent possible.
- Failure to satisfy either performance criterion constitutes a failure to comply with Waste Ban Regs and Waste Ban Compliance Plan
  - Cannot dispose or arrange for disposal of any C&D materials
  - Must transfer C&D materials to MPS-compliant facility
  - TS may choose to accept only C&D Residuals for disposal from an MPS-compliant facility

# **C&D MPS Implementation Plan**

#### CY2020

- C&D MPS went into effect in CY2020
- MassDEP shared C&D MPS facility status based on CY2019 data (RFI letters issued 6/30-8/10); next steps:
  - MassDEP analyzes revised annual report data
  - MassDEP provides feedback on RFI responses
  - Evaluate 1H2020 data to assess impact of COVID-19

#### CY2021


- Facilities submit CY2020 annual report data (2/15/2021)
- MassDEP publishes MPS facility status based on CY2020 data (ca. 4/30/2021)
- Start progressive enforcement approach at MPS non-compliant facilities
- MassDEP continues annual report data QA/QC and periodic site audits









# Request for Information (RFI) Letters


- Issued RFI Letters to all 17 C&D Processors and 12 Large C&D TSs (6/30-8/10)
  - 1. Collect monthly operational data for first 6 months of 2020
    - Better understand impact of COVID-19
    - Consider adjustments when evaluating compliance based on CY2020 annual report data
  - 2. Include questions to clarify CY2019 Annual Report Data
    - Improve data quality
- Full or partial responses received from all facilities, but not yet fully analyzed







# 1H2020 Monthly PSR Trend Chart 16 C&D Processors

#### **Combined average**







# 1H2020 Monthly PSR Trend Chart 11 Large C&D TSs

# Favorable Improvements

- Improved PSR operational performance
  - Casella Holyoke TS (on track to achieve MPS)
- Installed mechanical equipment to increase wood
  - Raynham Recycling Solution (RRSWPTS)
- Permit mods submitted to install mechanical separation equipment
  - 120 OBRRF
  - NEWD
  - UMM-Leominster
- Other process mods
  - WRS Roxbury (increased hours of operation)

# Potential Compliance Issues

- 7 processors consistently below 15% PSR
- Suspect that MPS Non-compliant Facilities continue to dispose, or arrange disposal, of C&D Materials
- Rail Haul TSs are accepting "C&D Residuals" from kick-sort only and MPS non-compliant facilities
- Un-processed or partially processed C&D
   Materials are being transferred to an out-of-state
   MPS non-compliant facility

## **Market Conditions**

#### Wood

- MPS driving facilities to separate more wood
- Generates more wood meeting spec for biomass or reuse as particle board
- The residual painted/treated wood (i.e. B-wood) is more concentrated and may be even less marketable
- Any B-wood allowance will have quantifiable limitations
  - First independently verify inbound wood characterization (% meeting spec vs. not)
  - Establish quantifiable limit on % of wood eligible for B-wood allowance

## Proposed Waste Ban Amendments

 Proposed Waste Ban amendments and revised WB Guidance

(http://www.mass.gov/eea/agencies/massdep/news/com ment/ )

- Lower applicability threshold
  - Commercial organic material (food material) from 1 ton to ½ ton/week
- Add two new waste ban materials
  - Mattresses
  - Textiles
- Revise Waste Ban Compliance Plan Guidance
- Public comment period
  - Public hearings: 11/09 and 11/12
  - Public comment period ends 12/04
- Anticipated Effective Date: 10/01/2021
  - submit revised WBCPs that reflect MPS requirements 3 months prior to effective date (ca. 7/01/2021)

# MassDEP Recycling Business Development Grant Program (RBDG)

<u>RBDG</u>: Intended to enhance waste reduction and recycling programs for Massachusetts based businesses.

- Grant awards range from \$50K to \$400K for eligible projects
- Match: grantee must contribute 25% of project investment
- Performance based component extends over 18 24 months

#### CY2020 Grant Cycle

  - Target materials include: C&D Materials Projects targeting cardboard, wood, metal, or clean gypsum wallboard that will increase the process separation rate at C&D handling facilities
- Applications deadline: 11/20/2020
